RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR BOWLING

Saint Vincent Bowling Lanes
Naguilian Road, Baguio City

1. Each team shall be composed of at least 2 females and the rest shall be males.
(Some districts or schools do not have luxury of having enough female employees)
2. A 15 - minute defaulting time will be strictly followed.
3. Elimination shall be SINGLE ROUND ROBIN and the TOP 6 Teams with the HIGHEST POINTS will be selected for the FINAL ROUND.
4. In case of TIE during the elimination round, all 6 players of both teams shall throw 3 balls each and a player in default shall have a zero (0) score.
5. The TOP 6 Teams shall play single round robin during the finals and their total pinfalls shall determine their respective final ranking.
6. Trophies and cash prizes shall be awarded to the Champion, 1st Runner - up, 2nd Runner-up, Highest Team Score, Highest Single, and Highest Pinning.
7. Request for postponement of games shall be entertained ONLY if majority of the players are ON OFFICIAL BUSINESS and should be filed 3 days before the given schedule.
8. As much as possible NO UNIFORM NO PLAY, or at least all players in the team should wear the same color.
9. **STRICTLY NO SMOKING OR DRINKING LIQUOR IN THE VENUE.**

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR MIX- VOLLEYBALL

A. Eligibility

1. Players must be employed in the School/District he/she represents.
2. A team is composed of players from the schools identified to be represented.

B. Team Composition

1. Maximum of 15 players (Inclusive of libero/s) a coach and assistant coach.
2. Only those above mentioned will be allowed to sit on their bench during games.
3. Teams must be with an authorized coach or representative.
4. Any misrepresentation on the teams' line up is subject to disqualification from the tournament.

C. Uniforms

1. Players must be in their color coded uniform. Numbers must be from 1 – 20 only (01 to 09 not allowed) please don't add 0 from numbers 1 to 9.
2. Dress code for team official (Coach and Assistant coach) polo shirt or jacket, long pants or jogging pants with shoes.

D. Game Rules

1. FIVB Rules shall be applied

Mix – Volleyball Ground Rules

2. There shall be three (3) males and three (3) females in the court as official Players during the game in all matches.
3. A team who opt to use a libero shall have at least two liberos, 1 male and 1 female.
4. Teams shall maintain the (3 – 3) (3 males and 3 females) members during games in all matches
5. In cases of teams not completing the 3 – 3 rule shall be declared incomplete and their game shall be forfeited in favor of the other
6. Teams who will not be in the playing venue 30 minutes before their scheduled game shall be declared - default. Game is forfeited in favor of the other.

E. Tournament Format

I. Preliminary/Elimination Round

- Single round robin for the elimination round.
- Best of three (3) sets (1-25)
- Top 8 teams will qualify to the quarter final round.
- Team ranking will be based on a WIN –LOSS standing of each team
- Breaking of tie: In case of tie after the elimination round, the following shall be applied:

First option:	Match Result	Winner	Loser
	2:0	3 points	0 point
	2:1	2 points	1 point

Second option: Total number of sets won by the team in all matches divided by the total number of sets lost by the team in

- all matches.
- Third option:** Total number of points accumulated by the team in all matches divided by the total number of points accumulated by the opposing teams in all matches.
- Fourth option:** Winner over the other

II. Quarter Final Round (Top 4 two to beat)

- Rank 1 vs. Rank 8
- Rank 2 vs Rank 7
- Rank 3 vs Rank 6
- Rank 4 vs Rank 5
- Best of 3 sets.

III. Semi-Final Round (Top 4 Teams- Rank 1 and 2 -- two to beat advantage)

- Rank 1 vs Rank 4
- Rank 2 vs Rank 3
- Best of 5 Sets (Set 5 1-15)

IV. Final Round

- Semi-final round losers will play for third place (Knock out Match)
- Semi-final round winners will play for the championship.
- Best of 5 sets (Set 5 1-15)

Note: The organizer of the tournament reserves the right to reschedule matches if deemed necessary.

Matters not included in this rules and regulations will be decided upon by the coaches or representatives headed by the tournament director in accordance with the updated FIVB rules.

TECHNICAL GUIDELINES

I. DATE AND VENUE

The 2014 Division Physical Fitness Program in Badminton will be held at PFVR Gym on September 18, 2014 onwards. Games start at 3:30 PM.

II. RULES

- a. The competition shall be held in accordance with the current Laws and Regulations of the Badminton World Federation (BWF). However, in matters not covered by these rules and regulations, decision shall rest with the Tournament Manager.
- b. The Technical Committee/Tournament Manager shall be responsible for the technical organization of the tournament. The decision of the committee in all matters regarding the competition shall be final.
- c. Only the team manager is allowed to approach the Match Control/Referee with regards to questions and inquiries during the match.

III. TOURNAMENT FORMAT

The format of the competition shall be run on a **Single Round Robin**

IV. SCORING SYSTEM

The BWF scoring system will be used. Best of three (2:3) games with advantage of two (2) in case the score ties in 20 all and ends with the score of 30 as the maximum number of points.

V. DETERMINING THE WINNERS

The most number of wins in a match will be considered the champion. The second most number of wins in a match will be considered 1st runner-up, 2nd runner-up respectively.

Breaking of Ties

1. Double Tie- Win over the other
2. Triple Tie- Number of sets won over number of sets loss
3. If triple tie persist, quotient system
4. If quotient system persist, toss coin (2 out of 3 toss)

VI. ENTRY OF PLAYERS

TEAM TIE (WD-MD-MXD)

- * Womens Doubles (WD) (One (1) entry/team)
- * Mens Doubles (MD) (One (1) entry /team)
- * Mixed Doubles (MXD) (One (1) entry/team)

Mandatory fielding of 4 players. (Minimum of 4 and maximum of 6 players as composition of a team)

Note: (Players in the mixed doubles should come from among the 4- 6 players)

VII. ATTIRE

All players must be on a prescribed badminton uniform/attire or team uniform.

VIII. PROTEST

Protest on technicality will be settled at the level of the Tournament Referee/Tournament Manager (Rosie Beel A. Marzo, Ed. D. cp # 09214652107 ,Lolita A. Manzano, Ed. D. cp.# 09998804372)

IX. UNFORSEEN EVENT

- a. The decision of the Tournament Manager on any disputes during the competition shall be final.
- b. The ongoing matches will be impossible to continue; such matches will be continued later from the point where it was disrupted.




