

CAPABILITY BUILDING ON LEARNING RESOURCES MANAGEMENT AND DEVELOPMENT SYSTEM FOR EDUCATION PROGRAM SUPERVISORS AND SCHOOL LRMDS COORDINATORS

- The Learning Resource Management and Development System (LRMDS) has been piloted in selected DepEd divisions in the country. Kalinga and Mt. Province Divisions in the Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR) have been piloting LRMDS for almost three years now. There is an immediate need for the LRMDS to be in operation in the Division of Baguio City.
- 2. In this connection, all Education Program Supervisors and School Learning Resources Management and Development System Coordinators are required to attend the Capability Building on Learning Resources Management and Development System (LRMDS) on October 12, 13 and 14, 2015 at the Division Office Conference Hall.
- The general objective of the training is to capacitate the Education Program Supervisor and school LRMDS coordinator on the Learning Resources Materials and Development System (LRMDS).
 The specific objectives are the following;
 - To intensify the School LRMDS coordinators' knowledge on LRMDS.
 - b. To initially organize the school LRMDS Quality Assurance Team
 - c. To acquaint the Education Program Supervisors and school LRMDS coordinators with the LRMDS assessment and evaluation tools
 - d. To initially prepare the school learning resource need assessment and school learning plan.
- 4. It is also instructed that Fourth year teachers who are designated as School LRMDS coordinators should have a representative for the said capability building for they are to participate in the Senior High School Fair.
- 5. All school LRMDS coordinators are to bring a copy of "My School, My Home" learning materials specifically the books which were distributed in every schools.
- 6. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
