

All teachers identified were asked their contact numbers and will be individually called for verification and briefing by the researchers. They will also be called for a one-day orientation on October 24, 8:00AM at the SNC Hall, DepEd-CAR, Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet prior to actual observation by the COT Team on November 3 to 13, 2015.

Transportation and other incidental expenses relative to the involvement of these teachers in the COT project will be borne by the PNRCTQ. Relative to the orientation on October 24, 2015, accommodation and food for Oct. 23, dinner and Oct. 24, breakfast and am snacks of the twenty-six (26) teachers who will be observed will be funded by PNRCTQ while actual travel expenses in coming to and returning to their respective stations will be reimbursed also by PNRCTQ.

The cooperation of all teachers identified and their school heads together with the division offices is requested for the success of the research, which results will eventually be beneficial to all teachers across the country.
