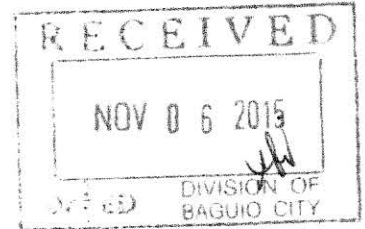


The UP Biology Society is an academic organization based in the University of the Philippines Baguio dedicated to advocating academic excellence and proficiency in the field of natural and life sciences.



3rd Inter-Elementary School Biology Quiz Show
CONTEST RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The contest is open to all students enrolled in the different elementary schools in Benguet.
2. There is to be only one (4) contestants who will represent each participating school. Each school must have at least one coach.
3. There will be a registration fee of **Php75.00** for the student and **Php50.00** for the coach upon joining the contest.
4. The quiz show proper is divided into two sets: the first set is the **group category** where a competing team shall be composed of three (3) members. The second set is the **individual category**, where only one (1) contestant, not belonging to the previous category of the registered members of the team, will represent their school. A fifteen-minute break is allotted between the two sets.
5. **Strictly no substitution of the contestants can be made during the contest proper.**
6. The competition will consist of an easy, average and difficult round. Both the easy and average rounds shall consist of **ten (10) questions** each while the difficult round shall consist of **fifteen (15) questions**. The questions for all rounds will be taken from the topics covered under the Science subject of a typical K-12 Elementary school curriculum.
7. The easy and average rounds shall consist primarily of multiple choice items. The difficult round shall consist primarily of identification type questions.
8. Each easy question must be answered within a period of **ten (10) seconds**. Average questions must be answered within a period of **fifteen (15) seconds**. Difficult questions must be answered within a period of **thirty (30) seconds**.
9. Each correct answer for the easy round shall be awarded **one (1) point**. Correct answers for the average round will be awarded **three (3) points**. Correct answers for the difficult round shall be awarded **five (5) points**.
10. Each question will only be read twice. Contestants may only begin writing their answer for the question **once the "go" signal is heard**.
11. Each individual will be provided with answering boards which must be immediately raised after the time limit for each question has elapsed and shall remain so until the quizmasters have verified their answers. **Final answers must be encircled at all times**. Multiple-choice questions must be answered in **capital letters**. There will be no corresponding deductions for wrong answers or failure to write down an answer.
12. Official BIOSOC members will be designated as watchers for each team or individual. They are given the task of inspecting and ensuring that the contest rules and regulations are strictly implemented. Any individual caught cheating will be disqualified.
13. Objections, clarifications and complaints regarding the question or answer must be done only until after the contestants' answers have been verified and shall be sustained before the next question is read; after which, they will no longer be entertained.
14. For such clarifications and complaints, a panel of judges selected by the organization shall decide on the matter in question. The judges' decision is final.
15. Cellular phones, handheld devices, and other electronic gadgets should be turned off or kept in silent mode. Contestants are barred from bringing these paraphernalia once they are already in their designated tables or once the contest has started.
16. Coaches, teachers and spectators are not allowed to approach the contestants while the quiz show is on-going.

17. The number of points for every round is cumulative and will be totalled at the end of the quiz show proper. The top three individuals that have scored the highest will be declared as the winners.
18. A bronze medal shall be awarded to the 3rd placer, a silver medal to the 2nd placer, and a gold medal to the 1st placer of the quiz show.
19. All participants, including their respective coaches, shall be given certificates of participation.
20. The school which has earned the top post based on ranking for the quiz show and poster making contest shall be awarded a trophy as grand champion of the event.

*The questions for each category of the quiz bee were prepared by the members of the Academic and Research Committee of the organization based on the topics offered under the Science subject of a typical K-12 elementary school curriculum. The questions were then submitted to the respective judges for the competition and the organization's adviser for validation and approval of these questions. After receiving the seal of approval from the judges, the questions were then collated and sealed. No further alterations or additions to the competition questions were made after which.

7th Poster Making Contest CONTEST RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The contest is open to all students enrolled in the different elementary schools in Benguet.
2. There is to be only one (1) contestant who will represent each participating school. Each school must have at least one coach.
3. A theme for poster-making shall be provided during the day of the contest.
4. Only cartolinas shall be provided by the organization during the contest. Contestants are encouraged to bring their own coloring materials.

9. Coaches, teachers and spectators are not allowed to approach the contestants while the contest is on-going.
10. Contestants must finish their posters within the time allotted for the competition. When allotted time is finished, all entries (finished or unfinished) will be collected.
11. After the contest, the judges will be allotted ample time to select the top three winning posters. The judges' decision is final.

Judging:

 - 3. Originality and Creativity** (unique, clever and/or creative design)

25th Inter-High School Biology Quiz Show
CONTEST RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The contest is open to all students enrolled in the different high schools Benguet.
2. There are to be four (4) contestants who will represent each participating school. Each school must have at least one coach.
3. There will be a registration fee of Php75.00 per student and Php50.00 per coach upon joining the contest.
4. The quiz show proper is divided into two sets: the first set is the **group category** where a competing team shall be composed of three (3) members. The second set is the **individual category**, where only one (1) contestant, not belonging to the previous category of the registered members of the team, will represent their school. A fifteen-minute break is allotted between the two sets.
5. **Strictly no substitution of the contestants can be made in both categories.**
6. Each set of the competition will consist of an easy, average, and difficult round. Both the easy and average rounds shall consist of **ten (10) questions each** while the difficult round shall consist of **fifteen (15) questions**. The questions for all sets will be taken from the topics covered by Biology under the K-12 high-school curriculum.
7. The easy round shall consist primarily of multiple choice items. The average round shall include both multiple choice (objective or problem solving) and identification type questions, the type of which shall be specified before each question for the round is read. The difficult round may include identification type or problem solving type items, the type of which shall also be specified before each question for the round is read.
8. Each easy question must be answered within a period of **ten (10) seconds**. Average questions must be answered within a period of **fifteen (15) seconds**. Difficult questions must be answered within a period of **twenty (20) seconds**. Problem solving questions will be given a **sixty (60) second** time period.
9. Correct answers for the easy round shall be awarded **one (1) point** for both objective and problem-solving questions. Correct answers for the average round, for both the objective and problem-solving questions, will be awarded **three (3) points**. Correct answers for the difficult round, for both the objective and problem-solving questions, shall be awarded **five (5) points**.
10. Each question will only be read twice. Contestants may only begin writing their answer for the question **once the "go" signal is heard**.
11. Each team or individual will be provided with answering boards which must be immediately raised after the time limit for each question has elapsed and shall remain so until the quizmasters have verified their answers. Sheets of scrap papers will be provided for each team or individual. **Final answers must be encircled** otherwise; the answer will not be accepted. Multiple-choice questions must be answered in **capital letters**. If the question requires any unit of measurement and the answer has none, it will be considered incorrect. There will be no corresponding deductions for wrong answers or failure to write down an answer.
12. Official BIOSOC members will be designated as watchers for each team or individual. They are given the task of inspecting and ensuring that the contest rules and regulations are strictly implemented. Any group/team/individual caught cheating will be disqualified.
13. Objections, clarifications and complaints regarding the question or answer must be done only until after the contestants' answers have been verified and shall be sustained before the next question is read; after which, they will no longer be entertained.

14. For such clarifications and complaints, a panel of judges selected by the organization shall decide on the matter in question. The judges' decision is final.
