- 1. Pursuant to the Deped Advisory No. 260, s. 2015 and Regional Memo no. 194 entitled "2015 Regional Filipino Values Month Celebration", Baguio Division enjoins the celebration of the Filipino Values Month.
- 2. To celebrate this year's theme "EsP: Katuwang sa Maunlad at Mapayapang ASEAN", the division will conduct a number of activities. The highlight will be the different contests: Tagis Talino, Poster making Contest and Sayawit on November 17, 2015 at Baguio City High School from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. In addition with this, teachers will also have a training workshop on EsP focusing on ASEAN integration.
- 3. This year's specific objectives are:
 - a. Deepen the knowledge and understanding of EsP teachers' roles and responsibilities in promoting the development of freedom loving and humane ASEAN.
 - b. Orient teachers with different and relevant strategies in teaching EsP in view of the ASEAN integration.
 - c. Identify the importance of ASEAN integration through the different activities of Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao celebration.
 - d. Provide opportunities for students/pupils from the public schools to come together to discover and develop their talents through competition.

CRITERIA AND MECHANICS OF THE DIFFERENT CONTESTS

TAGIS TALINO (For Secondary Grades 7-10 Only)

- 1. The Teams will compete in the easy (1 pt.), Average (3 pts.), and difficult (5 pts.) categories.
- 2. There will be 10 questions per category that relate to the learning competencies found in the resources material as provide in Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao grade 7,8,9 and 10.
- 3. The quizmaster will read the questions twice and the team will be given 15 seconds to choose their answer from them, then they wait for the quizmaster's signal to raise their answers. The scorers will check the answers and tally the scores on the scoreboard.
- 4. The three teams with the highest scores will be declared as winners.
- 5. In case of a tie, the quizmaster will ask a new set of three questions. The team with the highest score will automatically be declared as the winner.

SAYAWIT (Elementary Level Grade 4-6 / Secondary Level Grade 7-10)

- 1. Sayawit presentation must be relevant to the Values Education month's theme.
- 2. Presentation time should not exceed 10 minutes including entrance, exit and other preparation for stage.
- 3. Number of participants should be from 7 10 (singer and dancers, including technical assistants/instrumentalist, who are singing and dancing at the same time.
- 4. Contestants my use props and other stage set.
- 5. Live accompaniment is required and no lip-synchs.
- 6. Costumes must be appropriate to the movements.
- 7. There should no individual singing with the use of the microphone.

 - b. Pencil
 - c. Oil Pastel/Cray pas

- 2. Contestant are given 3 hours to finish work
- 3. Lettering and boarders are not allowed as part of the presentation
