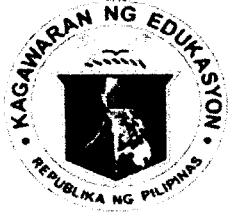
KASIBULAN FOOTBALL GRASSROOTS COURSE AND FESTIVAL NOV 09 2015

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 188, s. 2012, "**Kasibulan: 6-12 Football Grassroots Development Program Implementing Rules and Regulations**", a division Kasibulan Football Grassroots Course and Festival will be conducted by the Schools Division of Baguio City on November 21, 22 and 28, 2015 at the Baguio City High School Library and Melvin Jones Field.
2. The Seminar-Workshop is limited to the selected 50 teachers from public and private schools, elementary and secondary teachersin MAPEH and MSEP.
3. Expenses of the pupil-athletes and school coaches relative to their participation in the Program shall be shouldered by the Philippine Football Federation, Cordillera Region Football Association and the Cordillera Goshenland Football Club. No DepEd funds shall be used.
4. Public school teachers shall be entitled to a 3-day service credits and a certificate of participation for those who are assigned to participate in this athletic endeavor.

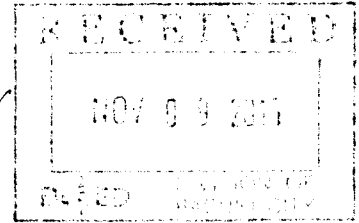
