ADJUSTED SCHOOL CALENDAR FOR SECOND SEMESTER SY 2015-2016

To

Chief Education Supervisors

Public and Private School Heads

- A review of the number of school days and contact days for the school year in light of class suspensions due to force majeureand Proclamation No. 1105, s.2015 'Declaring the Regular Holidays and Special (Non-Working) Days for the Year 2016' reveals that from June 1 to April 1, the average number of school days is 194 and the average number of contact days is 172.
- 2. DepED Order No. 9, s.2015 indicates that the school year shall consist of 201 days and that schools may observe national and local celebrations, holidays, and advocacy activities other than those indicated in the order provided that the total number of school days is not compromised. The computed averages mentioned previously clearly show the total numbers of school days and by inference, the number of contact days, are compromised.
- 3. To help ensure that all learners in the Division obtain a minimum of 'Satisfactory' at the end of the school year, the following adjusted school calendar for the Second Semester is hereby issued. All schools shall use this calendar as a guide in planning their calendar of activities starting November.
- 4. Private schools which did not start their school year on June 1 shall pay close attention to the difference betweenthe number of weeks/days from June 1 to the date of their school openingand this adjusted school calendar for the second semester in formulating their school calendar.
- 5. All school heads are reminded that the following are considered Non-Contact days
 - a. Saturdays scheduled for giving of cards/PTA Conferences;
 - b. School-wide examination/testing days;
 - c. School-based class suspensions for celebrations like Foundation Day, Sports Fest, School Christmas/Family Day, and other school days spent for activities deemed beneficial to the learning-teaching process.
- It is expected that School Heads of billetingschools which will host the Regional Math & Science Fair, Regional Technoloympics, and CARAA shall design school calendars incorporating additional Saturday Classes to make-up for lost contact days due to the said events.
- 7. All school shall submit their 3rd & 4th Quarter/2nd-4th Quarter Adjusted School Calendars not later than Nov. 27 in duplicate to the following:
