1. The Division Office will conduct the 2015 Araling Panlipunan Festival of Talents consisting of skills exhibition on December 4, 2015, 8:00 AM at Mabini Elementary School, Baguio City.
2. The festival aims to:
 - provide opportunities for students to show case their talents through exhibition of their performances as evidence of learning.
3. The participants of this competition will be the students of Public Elementary and Secondary School. The students will compete in the different areas. The winners in the secondary level will represent the division in the regional level.

5. Transportation and the registration fee of P60.00 per participant should be charged to school funds, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

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CRITERIA AND MECHANICS OF THE DIFFERENT CONTESTS

QUIZ BEE

1. The contestants (Individual/team) will bring their own markers or pens. The writing sheets will be provided by the organizers.
2. English or Filipino will be used as the official language in the conduct of the quiz.
3. The contestants (individual/team) will be given a total of twenty (20) questions, of which six (6) are "easy", seven (7) are "average" and seven (7) are "difficult"

Points for every correct answer will be given as follows:

One (1) point for each "easy" question

Two (2) points for each "average" question

Three (3) points for each "difficult" question

4. Participants shall be given ten (10) seconds to answer each question. For the Secondary, the questions that require computation, participants shall be given a maximum of thirty (30) seconds.
5. The quizmaster will only read each question twice. Countdown will start after the question has been read the second time.
6. The participants (individual/team) with the highest scores will be declared as winners.
7. All ties shall be broken by a tie-breaker question.
8. In case of a protest or inquiry during the actual quiz proceedings, the following procedures shall be observed.
 - Only the official coach of the participant is allowed to raise a protest or inquiry at the earliest appropriate time during the quiz.
 - The chair will announce the decision upon deliberation with the members of the Board of Judges.

"Daniw" (Poem)

1. The order of presentation shall be determined by drawing of lots.
2. The presentation must be delivered in 8 minutes, including entrance, exit and preparation for the props.

After 8 minutes, the participant may continue his/her presentation but a corresponding deduction will be given. (2 points from his score)

3. A committee member shall be assigned to ensure that the order in the audience is maintained during the presentation.
4. The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.

5. The criteria (pamantayan) for judging:

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On-the-Spot Skills Exhibition (For Secondary)

1. The theme of the activity will be announced on the actual day of the skills exhibition.
2. The participants for the essay will be provided with the writing pad sheets but for the poster making, the participants will bring their materials such as: ¼ illustration board, pencil, oil pastel/cray pas.
3. Essay must be at least 500 but not more than 600 words in English and legibly written in double space in the provided writing pad.

Essay must be original.

4. Any artwork in the poster must be original in design.
5. The jingle must be an original composition highlighting the theme. LYRICS must be in English. Performance must be done within two or three minutes.

Criteria for judging shall be based on the following:

Form, Content and Insight	- 60%
Accuracy	- 20%
Fairness (balanced, sound)	- 20%
Methodology	- 20%
