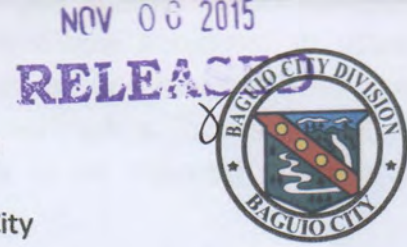


**2015 SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS DIVISION SEMINAR –WORKSHOP ON
CAMPUS JOURNALISM**

TO : Public Schools District Supervisors,

Public and Private School Paper Advisers (Elementary and Secondary)
Officers of School Paper Adviser Organization Division of Baguio

1. In preparation for the Division, Regional and National Press Conference and in line with the thrusts to promote responsible and free journalism and pursuant to the provision of section 2 of R.A. 7079, DepEd Division of Baguio shall conduct the 2015 SCHOOL PAPER ADVISER DIVISION SEMINAR WORKSHOP ON CAMPUS JOURNALISM on November 13-15, 2015 at Lucban Elementary School.
2. The Seminar-Workshop aims to:
 - a. To equip SPA with the needed skills to be effective mentors.
 - b. To hone the journalistic skills of the campus staffers to improve their performance in the upcoming Division, Regional and National Schools Press Conference.
 - c. To raise the level of competence on different aspects of campus journalism and school paper advising.
3. The seminar-workshop shall consist of lectures discussions on the following areas:

4. Participants to the seminar-workshop are:
 - a. All Campus Paper Advisers in private and public elementary and secondary schools in the Division of Baguio City.
 - b. All interested teachers who want to learn about campus journalism.

5. A registration fee of Php.500.00 which can be charged against school campus journalism funds or any other sources of funds available subjected to usual accounting and auditing rules. Registration fees cover honoraria of resource speakers, printing of certificates, reproduction of materials/kits, food and snacks of the participants, and other incidental expenses to be incurred during the conduct of the seminar - workshop.
6. Pre-registration shall be done on or before November 10, 2015 to give enough time for the Division School Paper Advisers Association (DSPAA) officers to invite more speakers should there be more participants.
7. School Paper Advisers will be entitled for a 2-day service credits while 2-day compensatory day off shall be granted to the non-teaching employees for the services rendered on Saturday (November 14, 2015) and Sunday (November 15, 2015).
8. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
