

The Philippine Mental Health Association Baguio-Benguet Chapter, Inc. under its project, Kampus Bayani, has launched a search for underprivileged teenagers who exhibit the highest degree of sound mental health by being a good model in their schools, families, and communities in spite of their poor economic condition.

The Kampus Bayani Search aims to recognize ordinary students who live extra ordinary roles in life. Since its inception in 2001, more than 400 students were given the Kampus Bayani Award. Many of them were also given college scholarships by PMHA BBCI and generous organizations like the Rotary Club of Baguio, Monday Afternoon Club, and Commission on Higher Education CAR among others. Some of the Kampus Bayanis are now successful in their professions.

The project is being implemented in the 25 member high schools of Baguio City and Benguet Province through the Lakas Isipan ng Kabataan (LINK) Clubs of the PMHA BBC. The criteria for the Kampus Bayani are as follows:

- belongs to a family with a yearly income of 100,000.00 and below;
- contributes to the welfare of the family as sibling caregiver or engaged in an enterprise;
- contributes to the community welfare by participating in a civic project or exhibits heroism during a calamity;
