2015 DIVISION LEVEL TECHNOLYMPICS

TO : CID and SGOD Chiefs, EPSs, PSDs, Elementary and Secondary School Principals/Heads, TLE Head Teachers, TLE and EPP Officers (Public and Private)

1. This is to announce the conduct of the 2015 Division Level Technolympics to be held on December 11-13, 2015 at 9:30 a.m. at the PFVR Multipurpose Building, upper Session Road, Baguio City.
2. Participants to this Technolympics are the PSDs, Coaches, Principals, teachers and the top three (3) winners from the six (6) elementary and four(4) secondary districts in all the skills contested duly certified by the Public District Supervisor.
3. Each secondary contestant and coach (both Elementary and Secondary) will be charged a registration fee of fifty pesos (P50.00) and thirty (P30.00) for the elementary contestant which shall be paid directly to the Division Office cashier to defray the cost of the conduct of the activity. A receipt of payment should always be issued to the payee upon payment. All contestant will bring their own materials or will contribute for the cost of material needed for the contest skill.
4. All participants will convene at PFVR before 9:30 a.m. on December 11, 2015 for the opening program. Each district will prepare a yell to be presented during the opening program.
5. There will be a brief meeting of all coaches in every skill contested to be conducted by the contest administrator just after the opening program. Mechanics and guidelines as to the conduct of each skill contest will be announced during the opening program.
6. Teacher and non-teaching personnel participants will be granted two (2) days service credit/COC in lieu of December 12 and 13, 2015 that falls on a Saturday and Sunday. Form 48 should be accomplished right after the activity and should be submitted to the division office c/o Dr. Esther Y. Melecio, TLE & EPP Supervisor.
7. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is enjoined.
