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1. This is to announce the schedule of **Baguio City High School Qualifying Examinations for Special Program in the Arts (SPA)**.

Date & Venue of Examinations:

Written Test – April 2, 2016 (Saturday) 9:30 AM BCHS DepEd Bldg.

Interview & Performance Test – April 7 & 8, 2016 (Thursday & Friday) 8:00 AM BCHS SPA Rooms

2. **Application Forms** will be available starting third week of January, 2016 at the BCHS Guidance Services Office.

3. **Requirements and Fees:**

Each applicant must submit his/her :

- a. Duly accomplished application form
- b. Two (2) latest and identical 2" x 2" pictures with name tag
- c. Photocopy of Grade VI Report Card duly certified correct by the Elementary Principal OR bring the original copy of Report Card together with a photocopy to be certified by the BCHS Guidance Counselor

Grade requirement (Third Grading Period)

A general average of 83 % or higher and no grade lower than 80 % in any subject

- d. Medical Certificate issued by a government physician, elementary school physician or private physician
- e. Two Hundred Pesos examination fee for test materials, honorarium and other incidental expenses

4. **Areas:**

- (a) **DANCE** - Develops learner's techniques, movement, vocabulary and a deeper understanding of dance as a form of communication and expression.
- (b) **DIGITAL ARTS** - Teaches learners to use elements and tools of current and emerging technologies to create works that express feelings and ideas; learners will be trained to analyze and create work through photography, video, audio, computer arts, interactive media and film production.
- (c) **THEATER ARTS** - Emphasizes on group work skills and live performance of spoken text in a number of styles and genres; contemporary and classical acting techniques will be introduced.
- (d) **VISUAL ARTS** - Helps learners discover what they can produce through their own creativity through paintings, printmaking, creative crafts and designs, computer graphics, sculpture, etc.
- (e) **LITERARY ARTS (English & Filipino)** - Train learners to explore and write their own ideas and experiences; they will study and work on all genres like poetry, fiction, non-fiction, etc.
- (f) **MUSIC :Band,- Rondalla & Vocal (Choir)** - Designed for dedicated music learners with interest in vocal or instrumental music
 - Band Instruments** : Flute, Trumpets, Altosax, Clarinets, Tenor Sax, Trombones, Percussion/Drums
 - Rondalla Instruments** : Violin, Guitar, Banduria, Octavina, Bass

5. **Filing Period** starts on February 1, 2016 at Baguio City High School Guidance Services Office. Walk – in applicants with complete requirements will be accepted on April 2, 2016 (test day).

6. **Individual Filing** by the learner or parent/guardian or **Group Filing** by the official representative of the elementary school (Guidance Counselor / Adviser).

7. **Results of the examinations** shall be posted in the school bulletin board.
