**DIVISION MASS TRAINING OF GRADE 5 TEACHERS ON K TO12 BASIC
EDUCATION PROGRAM**

**TO : Public Schools District Supervisor
School Administrators, Principals, Head Teachers,
Teacher-in-Charge
(Public Schools)**

1. In line with the implementation of the K to 12 Basic Education Program, the Department of Education (DepED), through the Bureau of Elementary Education(BEE), and in coordination with the Regional Office(RO) and Schools Division Office(SDO), shall conduct the GRADE 5 DIVISION MASS TRAINING on April 18-23, 2016 to be held at Brentwood Apartelle, Trancoville, Baguio City.
2. The Division Mass Training aims to:
 - a. Build the capacity of Grade 5 teachers to implement the K to 12 curriculum.
 - b. Provide a clearer understanding on the K to 12 curriculum framework.
 - c. Enrich their understanding of the K to 12 academic standards, competencies and content standards to be taught in Grade 5.
 - d. Capacitate Grade 5 teachers on formulating and delivering of their teaching plans and assessment.
3. Training costs, which cover meals and snacks (complete from first day to last day), training venues, supplies and materials shall be charged to the 2016 Continuing Human Resource Training and Development (HRTD) Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
4. Participants of EPP are required to bring their personal laptop with USB Wifi.
5. Attendance of participants is a **MUST**.
6. The participants, trainers and management staff in the Division Mass training shall be entitled to service credits for teachers while compensatory service credits(COC) for non-teaching staff.
7. Wide and immediate dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned is desired.
