



- 2. The training aims to:
- explain the concepts in the Elementary / High School modules on population and development , human sexuality and responsible parenthood.
 - contextualize the lessons in the modules.
 - apply the relevant pedagogical tools in the lessons.
- 3. The participants to this training are:
 - Two (2) Education Program Supervisors
- One (1) Grade 10 Araling Panlipunan teacher in the newly legislated schools, 2 teachers of PCNHS, 2 teachers of INHS and 2 teachers of BCHS
 - Five (5)- Secondary School Heads/ Head Teachers (Araling Panlipunan/ Science) (BCHS, PCNHS, INHS, Magsaysay NHS, Doña Aurora NHS)
 - Four (4) Science Teachers/ Guidance Counselors in Grade 6
 - (1-Baguio Central Elem. School, 1-Lucban Elem School, 1-Josefa Cariño Elem. School, 1- Mabini Elem School)
 - Four (4) Elementary School Heads

 (San Vicente Elem School, Dominican Mirador Elem. School, Fairview Elem School and Quezon Hill
 Elem. School)
- 4. No registration to be collected. The training expenses, meals and snacks will be charged to the City Population Office.
- 5. The teachers will be entitled for three (3) day service credits for the services rendered during the training.
