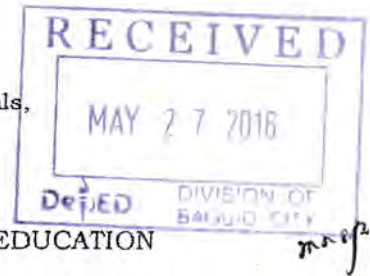

NATIONAL SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON LEARNER-CENTERED EDUCATION
