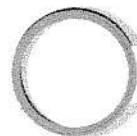

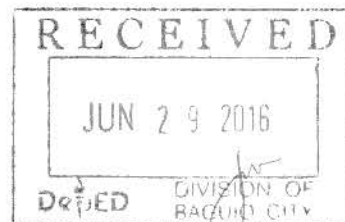

S & T QUIZ

July 26, 2016

Description

The contest is an integrated ICT, mathematics, science and technology quiz for groups of pupils/students from the elementary and secondary schools visiting the Regional Science and Technology Fair. The quiz shall be conducted on July 26, 2016, morning for the Elementary and afternoon for the High School, at Benguet State University gymnasium, La Trinidad, Benguet.

Conditions

1. Only the first **30 schools** per category to submit their filled-up registration form will be accommodated.
2. Only one (1) team, composed of two (2) members, shall represent a school. It is the prerogative of the school to choose the grade/year level of the students to compose their team as long as the maximum number of two (2) members is completed.
3. To participate, the coach must fill-up the registration form and return not later than **July 14, 2016** to **DOST-CAR Regional Office, BSU Compound, Km. 6, La Trinidad, Benguet** or fax at **(074) 422-2214, 422-0979** or email to **rstlcar@gmail.com**
4. For pre-registered schools that cannot make it during the quiz proper, the organizer will open the vacant slot to walk-in participants.

Rules and Mechanics

1. All approved/eligible competing teams shall be assigned a corresponding quiz table to occupy in the contest area. Each team will be provided with flashcards (labeled A, B, C, and D), pencil and bond papers to be used in solving.
2. Three (3) sets of questions composed of ten (10) questions each shall be posed to the competing teams. The first set shall be the easy category with a total of 10 points, followed by the average category with a total of 20 points, and the difficult category with a total of 30 points.
3. Each question will be flashed on the screen and read by the quizmaster twice. The quizmaster will signal the start of the timer.
4. Competing teams shall be allotted 10 seconds for objective type of questions and 30 seconds for problem-solving type of questions.
5. At the end of the allotted time, the quizmaster announces "stop."
6. The quizmaster will ask the team leader to raise the answer board and team number facing front.
7. The teams with incorrect answers will lower their answer board while the teams with correct answers have to keep their boards raised until the

quizmaster has finished announcing the numbers of the teams with correct answers.

8. The team which garners the highest points shall win the quiz. If a tie prevails, tie breaking questions will be posed. The team that gets the first correct answer shall win.
9. Coaching from the audience will not be allowed during the quiz proper.
10. A challenge to a question should be made by the coach to the panel of advisers only. The challenge should be given before the next question is asked. The panel of advisers will confer and decide whether the challenge is valid or not. The decision of the panel of advisers is final and not appealable
