Participants to the NSCM Celebration Seminar/Workshop are the Regional / Division / District Supervisors, Principals, Department Heads, Master Teachers, Science Teachers, Science Club Advisers , Science Coordinators, Special Education Teachers , Laboratory School Teachers , Out of School Science Club Members, Barangay Leaders, Parents and Science Enthusiasts.
2. Activities during the NSCM Celebration Seminar/ Workshop includes plenary sessions , group dynamics, interactive workshop , round table discussion, poster sessions, practicum, and assessment geared toward the achievement of objectives..
3. The Regional Directors, Schools Division Superintendents and School Heads are encourage to send their participants to the Seminar/ Workshop. The Regional Science Supervisor in charge of the Programs and Projects shall undertake the coordination in the field offices pertinent to their participation in the seminar.
