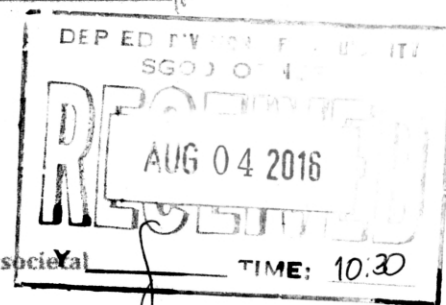

In this regard, may we humbly request for an endorsement from your good office? MC believes that this endorsement and information will help in the overall success of the event.


Interested schools who will participate in the *Pintig at Pantig 9* should confirm their attendance on or before August 20, 2016 since the event has limited slots.


