The Baguio Center for Young Adults, Inc. has been an advocate of "Anti-Drug Use" for the past years. Since 2006 we have been in partnership with the LGU-Baguio/City Anti-Drug Abuse Council (CADAC) and the Dep Ed/DO-Baguio City in the implementation of the project: "Life Planning as a Resource Intervention for Anti-Drug Education" (Life PRIDE) together with identified elementary and high schools.

The role of school mentors and peer groups in drug prevention has an influence to positive change behavior and healthy lifestyle of young people to include learning skills to manage life challenges and say NO to use of prohibited drugs.

In the past 9 years (2006-2015) BCYA have mentored over 200 public school mentors and have reached more than 15,000 public elementary pupils and high school students.
