3. The SOFAD is open to all current registered Boy Scouts (Boy/Senior/Rover/Roverette) and Girl Scouts (Junior/Senior/Cadet). Boy/Junior/Senior Scouts (BSP/GSP) who served in previous SOFAD are no longer qualified.

4. a. Guidelines

- a.1. Each Sponsoring Institution with a duly registered Boy/Senior/Rover/Cadet unit (minimum of 24 Scouts) is entitled to one (1) candidate/unit.
- a.2. The BSP and GSP SOFAD Screening Committees will conduct a separate Written Test and Interview

b. Qualifications

- b.1. Boy/Senior/Rover Scouts or Junior/Senior/Cadet Scouts must be duly registered for school year 2016 2017
- b.2. Boy/Senior/Rover Scouts or Junior/Senior/Cadet Scouts must be a holder of 2nd Class rank for Boy Scouts and Pathfinder for Senior Scouts
- b.3. Girl Scout candidates must submit a record or earned badges

c. Criteria

1.	Interview	25%	3.	Written Examination	15%
2.	Scouting Participation	35%	4.	Advancement	25%


