

# SONG COMPETITION

### **DESCRIPTION:**

To develop the personality, emotional and intellectual capabilities and impart education with a firm moral base so that our children may grow as men and women of character and to encourage them for keener participation in various school activities and foster a spirit of belongingness and healthy competition.

# **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- 1. This is a group competition with a maximum of five (5) performers and open to all students in both private and public schools and Alternative Learning system.
- 2. There will be three (3) categories:
  - a. Elementary
  - b. High School (Junior or Senior High School)
  - c. Alternative Learning System


**THEME:** "Fostering a Meaningful Change through Synergy and Cooperation"

### **SONG LYRICS:**

- 1. The message of the song must be aligned to the theme
- 2. The lyrics of the song maybe in Filipino or English
- 3. It must consist of three (3) stanzas with a refrain/chorus. Each stanza must have 4-5 lines

# MANNER OF PRESENTATION/PERFORMANCE OF SONG:

- 1. Pop Music except Metallic Rap and Rap
- 2. Delivered in not more than five (5) minutes



### **INSTRUMENTATION:**

One or more combination of instruments except drum set. Pre-recorded accompaniment may be used. Participants will bring their own instruments or CD for those who opt to use pre-recorded accompaniment.

# **CRITERIA FOR JUDGING:**

Originality - 30%
Musicality - 25%
Relevance to the Theme - 30%
Over-all performance - 15%
TOTAL 100%

- 1. Each school will choose its participants. (One (1) entry per school)
- 2. a. Public Schools
  - Pre screening per district
  - The first in rank in the district will be qualified to participate in the citywide contest
  - District Winner will submit a hardcopy of the lyrics and audio file in a CD (MP3 format) to Dr. Juliet Sannad on or before October 4, 2016

# b. Private Schools

- Administrators with entry will inform Ms. Annie Marie B.
   Caguioa through text message on or before September 19, 2016 (CP No. 0917-506-0865)
- Submission of a hardcopy of the lyrics and audio file in a CD (MP3 format) on or before 5:00PM, September 30, 2016 at the Principal's Office, University of Baguio Science High School and look for Ms. Erlina De Peralta

- Pre Screening for Private Schools will be on October 4, 2016 at 3:00 PM for Elementary and October 5, 2016 at 3:00 PM for High School.

All Public School District Winners and Private School Contestants will subjected to final judging on October 7, 2016. Awarding of prizes to the winners will be on October 17, 2016 during the flag raising ceremony.


