**Program synopsis:**

The study trip aims to engage students to think about how China (Hong Kong and Beijing) and Singapore and Kuala Lumpur) have educated, and empowered its youth to occupy and replace leadership positions of the country. From the school, to significant institutions and partnerships of IGO's and NGO's, the programs gets into how human resource is planned, designed and managed to enhance quality of life. By learning about the youth leadership development of different countries and exploring various leadership initiatives in the city-state through self-guided field trips, students will reflect on the relationship between leadership and liveability and present ideas on how to enhance the liveability of their own towns and cities thus make China, Singapore and Malaysia an economic tigers in Asia.

**Learning values:** Planning for a strong nation requires a robust population. With 1.6 billion Chinese in the world, and a melting pot of races for Singapore and Malaysia, this presents a challenge to the governments as they need to not only plan for cities that have the necessary infrastructure, but also with strong population especially empowering the growing youth. By participating in this program, students will acquire greater awareness of the centrality of the built environment to liveability and how they will prepare themselves for a greater task ahead of them. They will learn more about Singapore and KL and Hong Kong and Beijing's urban development as a global city and explore how the built environments are designed to balance the needs and aspirations of a diverse population, meet the challenges of an ageing population and promote an environmentally sustainable lifestyle. Through a learner-centered approach, students will also be challenged to hone critical thinking and communication skills and acquire knowledge and articulate ideas that can be applicable in local context.
