

## CONTEST MECHANICS

2. Choose a theme in your category:

### Category A

(7-9 years old)

- Floods/Typhoons
- Volcanic eruption/Lahar
- Earthquake
- Fire
- Landslide/Trashslide
- Environmental destruction due to mining, illegal logging, and other projects

### Category B

(10-12 years old)

- Drought
- Fishkill/Redtide
- Infestation
- Epidemic
- War / Armed conflict
- Climate Change

## WINNERS

- Winners will be informed through phone or by letter.
- Major prize winners will each get P5,000 cash prize; finalists P1,000 each.
- Prizes not claimed within 6 months will be forfeited.
- Finalists and winning entries shall become CDRC property and featured in the 2017 CDRC Disaster Preparedness Calendar and other promotional materials.
- Non-winning entries can be reclaimed at the CDRC ofc. Entries not claimed within 60 days after the announcement of winners shall be considered donations to CDRC.

- A maximum of two entries per participant
- Two-time winners of previous ABKD can no longer join
- Posters that have won or have been submitted in other contests won't be accepted
