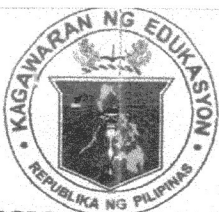

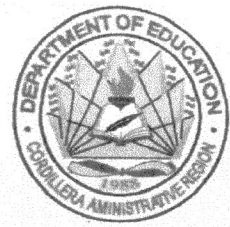

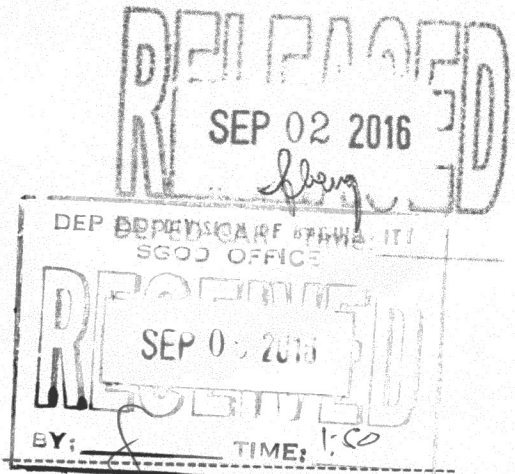

5. The best stories will also be featured as part of the exhibits during the 2016 Basic Education Congress of DepEd CAR and special citations shall be bestowed to the authors and featured teacher/s.

Division Information Officers and Social Mobilization Specialists are hereby tasked to source out and collate these stories and submit them through email to the DepEd Regional Office (pau.depedcar@gmail.com or car@deped.gov.ph) and copy furnish the DepEd Central Office (glorydee.magno@deped.gov.ph or Erika.daza@deped.gov.ph). Stories shall be sent within the duration of said celebration, however, deadline is set on October 7, 2016.
7. Other activities relative to said celebration within the division, district, and school levels shall be appropriately documented by the Social Mobilization Units and shall submit comprehensive (written and photo documentation) completion reports to the Regional Office on or before October 11, 2016.
8. Expenses incurred relative to the conduct of the activities for the said celebration shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules.
