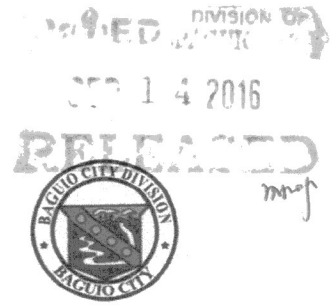



**GUIDELINES IN THE CONDUCT OF 2016 DISTRICT MATHEMATICS FESTIVAL
AT QUEZON AND NORTH QUEZON DISTRICTS**

1. The 2016 District Mathematics Festival is scheduled on September 24, 2016 at Mil-an National High School. Attached are the guidelines and mechanics as well as the agreed terms in the conduct of all contests in the Districts of Quezon and North Quezon.
2. The guidelines specify the procedures in administering each contested areas in Quiz Bee and in Damath, in which the different working committees are identified for systematic flow.
3. All District Mathematics officers are expected to be at the venue before 8:00 to ensure that all rooms and materials are ready for the event.
4. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

DISTRICT MATH FESTIVAL: September 24, 2016 (Saturday)
TIME: 7:30 - 8:00 - Registration
8:00 - Start of Program
VENUE: MIL-AN NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL (Loakan Proper)
REGISTRATION FEE: 50.00 per student contestant - to be given during the contest day

A. QUIZ BEE (TOP 4 per District)

1. School: ONE representative per grade level for ORAL Quiz Bee (Grade 7 - 10)
ONE representative to represent the school for WRITTEN Quiz Bee
(May be coming from any grade level)
2. Tasks: Every school to submit **4 questions each for EASY, AVERAGE, & DIFFICULT**
 - **K to 12 content**
 - To be printed on a short bond paper (ARIAL 12) WITH ANSWERS
 - To be submitted during the contest day
 - **Four (4) questions** on a short bond paper (8.5" x 11")



1. Each contestant will be provided with slips of paper for the answer to each question. Before the contest proper, the contestant will write the assigned number on each slip.
2. There shall be 25 questions. There are three (3) rounds in each competition namely: Easy, Average, and Difficult. The Clincher round takes place only if there is a tie. Questions will be read twice by the Quizmaster.
 - a. For the EASY ROUND, ten questions are to be answered mentally. Writing anywhere, neither on paper, the table, etc. is not allowed. After the second (2nd) reading, the Quizmaster shall say "go". Only then will the contestants be allowed to write their answer. Automatically, the fifteen (15) second time - limit will begin with the word "go" by the Quizmaster.
 - b. For the AVERAGE ROUND, ten questions are to be answered. After the first (1st) reading, the contestants are allowed to start solving and write their final answer on the slip of paper. Automatically, the thirty (30) second time - limit will begin with the word "go" by the Quizmaster.
 - c. For the DIFFICULT ROUND, five questions are to be answered. The contestants are immediately allowed to solve, and write their answer. A one (1) minute time limit will be given.
3. Answers must be given complete with units and to the required accuracy. However if the unit is already given in the way the question is asked, it need not be given in the answer.
4. After the time limit and the buzzer sounds, the contestants must stop writing and raise the slip of paper.
5. The Quizmaster shall read and verify the contestants' answer.
6. Points are assigned for each question answered correctly:
 - . Easy question 2 points
 - . Average question 3 points
 - . Difficult question 5 points
7. After the fifth (5th) question in the Difficult Round, the total number of points of each contestant is tabulated.
8. The contestant will be ranked according to their total score. Top four will proceed to the Division Level.
9. In case any qualified contestant is unable to compete in the next contest level, the next in rank will take the place of the contestant.
10. The duly registered teacher - coach or contestant are authorized to make a protest.
11. All protest should be referred to the Board of Judges immediately, before the Quizmaster reads the next question.
12. The Board of Judges shall be in complete control of the contest. Their decision shall be final in all questions/ protests.
