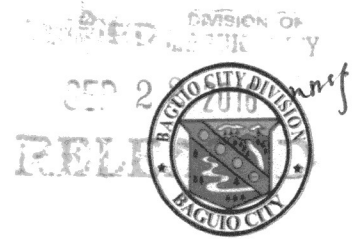




DIVISION MEMORANDUM

THEME : JUAN SCIENCE ONE NATION

OCTOBER 7 & 8, 2016

Venue : PFVR / M.L.QUEZON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL/ DIVISION OFFICE CONFERENCE HALL

1. QUIZ BEE (Oct. 8, 2016 –Manuel L. Quezon Elem. School)

Agreements with District Coordinators :

- Coverage for Science quiz will include First and Second Quarter topics.
- For Grades 3, 4, 5, Grades 7 to 10, topics will be based on the K-12 Curriculum guide.
- For Grade 6, topics will be based on RBEC 2010 Curriculum guide.
Grade 6- Nervous and Circulatory systems (except Lymphatic and endocrine system),
Ecosystem
- All coaches are to prepare questions ; one per category :
 - * Easy and Average (Multiple choice)
 - * Difficult and Clincher (Fill in the blanks / Identification).
 - * Each district to submit five (5) questions per category from which the EPS will select two questions for Elementary, 3 questions for Junior High School to be read during the quiz proper.

4. Strategic Intervention Materials (Past three years)

- Top Five Winners in the District Level Competition per grade level ; submit three copies
- Reminder :
For Strategic Intervention Material(SIM) for Students with Learning Difficulty in a certain Competency
 - a. The write –up should be present, the evidence that it is a least learned competency, thus the material is needed. The competency to be addressed should be stated.
 - b. The write –up and the SIM project should be packaged as one(1).
 - c. The certification of the school head that it has been used in the school.
Means of verification should be placed after the reference card.
 - d. The Title Card, Guide Card, Activity Card, Assessment Card, Enrichment Card, Reference Card and Answer Card should be in separate pages
 - Each activity should be in a separate page so with its Answer Card
 - Reference Card can bear the reference/s or the needed Science Concepts that the students should know(something that they can refer to).
 - Pictures should be found in the locality(contextualized).
 - Color blending and font size should be considered.
 - e. Others can be found in the criteria

BAGUIO CITY DIVISION LEVEL SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (SHS) QUIZ BEE

GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS

1. The **Division Level Senior High School Quiz Bee** shall be conducted in a Written Quiz Show Format.
2. The coverage of the quiz bee shall be the **competencies of Grade 10 Science** as indicated in the **K to 12 Curriculum Guide for Science**:

3. Only **Top 3 teams per District** are qualified to join the division level. Each team shall be comprised of three members who are **Senior High School Students** across the four tracks.
4. There shall be three (3) rounds for all categories: **EASY, AVERAGE, and DIFFICULT**. Easy and Average rounds shall have multiple choice questions while Difficult and Clincher rounds shall be fill in the blanks or identification. All contestants shall answer all questions in the three rounds. Each correct answer in every round will be given corresponding points and time allocation, to wit:

Easy	-	1 point	-	10 seconds
Average	-	2 points	-	20 seconds
Difficult	-	3 points	-	30 seconds
Clincher	-	1 point	-	Knockout System
5. The pool of questions will be coming from the four districts. Each district shall submit four questions per round; i.e. 4 for easy, 4 for average, and so on, encompassing the four learning areas in Grade 10 science: Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Earth and Space. The four questions per round shall be:

Question 1	-	Biology
Question 2	-	Chemistry
Question 3	-	Physics
Question 4	-	Earth and Space

 - A total of 16 questions will be collected from each district to be submitted on September 28, 2016 by the respective district coordinators.
6. Each team will be provided with a board where their answers will be written. A code number will be assigned per contestant.
7. Only authorized persons are allowed to stay during the contest proper. Borrowing of tools and materials from the competitors is not allowed while the contest is in progress. Contestants are not allowed to use cellular phones/mobile phones and the like during the contest.
8. The quizmaster shall read each question twice and the time to answer shall start only after the quizmaster says **GO**.
9. All answers must be spelled correctly to be considered. If the answer is a proper noun, capitalization of the first letter of word is also a basis in declaring an answer correct.
10. After the time limit has expired, each team must show their answer to the audience before the quizmaster reads the correct answer. The proctors shall read and acknowledge whether the answer of each contestant is correct or not.
11. Questions or clarifications will be taken care of by coaches present.
12. The total score of a team after three rounds shall be the basis for ranking.
13. In case of tie, three clincher questions will be read. If the same result continues, **do or die** will be followed.
14. Top five (5) teams shall be proclaimed winners.
