2016 SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS NATIONAL SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON CAMPUS JOURNALISM

Public School Paper Advisers**

1. In preparation for the Division, Regional and National Press Conferences and with the aim to promote responsible and free journalism, pursuant to the provision of section 2 RA 7079, the Division of Baguio will conduct the **2016 SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS NATIONAL SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON CAMPUS JOURNALISM** from October 6 to 8, 2016 at the Baguio City Division Office Conference Hall.

2. With the upcoming NSPC and in line with the theme, "*Strengthening Freedom of Information through Campus Journalism*", the seminar-workshop has the following objectives:

- a. To equip the School Paper Advisers (SPA) with needed skills to be effective mentors;
- b. To hone journalistic skills of campus staffers to improve their performance in the upcoming Division, Regional and National Schools Press Conferences,
- c. To raise the level of competence on different aspects of campus journalism and school paper advising.

3. The said seminar-workshop shall consist of lectures and discussions from speakers in the National level, under English and Filipino on the areas as listed below:



4. Participants to this seminar-workshop are identified campus SPA public elementary and secondary schools of the Division of Baguio City.

5. A registration of Php 1,500.00 will be collected from participants and can be charged against campus journalism fund and school MOOE. Registration fees shall cover honoraria of resource speakers, training kits, certificates and other incidental expenses to be incurred during the conduct of seminar-workshop. Meals and snacks will be charged from the SEF fund.
6. Pre-registration is on or before October 5 to facilitate and maximize the time for the said seminar-workshop.
7. School Paper Advisers will be entitled for a one-day (1) service credit while one-day (1) compensatory day off shall be granted to non-teaching employees for services rendered on Saturday (October 8, 2016).
8. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is desired.




