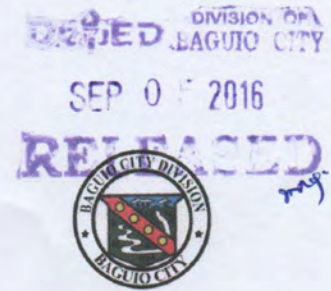

SUBJECT: **22<sup>nd</sup> NATIONAL CRIME PREVENTION WEEK**

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 235 s. 2016, the Department of Education joins the National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM) and other agencies in observing the 22<sup>nd</sup> National Crime Prevention Week.
2. With the theme, "Hawak Kamay Tungo sa Kapayapaan at Kaunlaran," this activity aims to generate community awareness and appreciation of the importance and value of crime prevention and foster interest and participation of the general public.
3. In this regard, the schools are encouraged to support said observance and undertake related activities such as the following:
  - a. Integration of the celebration in the different subject areas;
  - b. Hoisting of streamers or banners depicting this year's theme and logo;
  - c. Conduct of a drug awareness forum/crime prevention forum for parents and students in coordination with your local Philippine National Police (PNP) or Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) or other related local government instrumentalities; and
  - d. Organizing of activities like art contests, poster-making and slogan-making contests, and other related contests in line with the theme.
4. These proposed activities can be scheduled within the month of September. A comprehensive report shall be submitted to the Division Social Mobilization Section on or before September 26, 2016.
5. Expenses incurred relative to the conduct of the activities for the said celebration shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules.
6. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
