#### **DATE AND VENUE**

The 12<sup>th</sup> INTER-HIGHSCHOOL BRAIN COLLISION will be held on November 29, 2016 (Tuesday) from 1:30 pm to 5:30 pm at the Center for Culture and the Arts Theater (CCA) of Saint Louis University.

#### REGISTRATION

1. An initial registration via e-mail on or before 12nn of November 18, 2016 is required. It must include the name of the school and the list of complete names (with middle initial) of the participants and the coach. Kindly fill up the form attached (see page 6) and send it via e-mail as a pdf file. Please do note that if there would be a need to change the participating students for the team, kindly inform us on or before November 22, 2016 so we may comply with the necessary adjustments for the said event, thus no changes can be made after the said date. 

- 2. An official registration should be made before the start of the contest proper by submitting the original copy of the registration form on November 29, 2016. There will be a registration booth at the entrance of the Center for Culture and the Arts Theater.
- 3. Upon the submission of the Official Registration Forms, only the **REGISTERED** students shall be allowed to compete in the entire quiz show and no changes can be made.
- A registration fee of four hundred pesos per team (400/team) shall be collected. This shall cover the snacks, certificates, trophies and awards.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

- 1. Only **one team** is allowed to represent its respective school.
- A team shall be composed of two (2) twelfth/eleventh year students, two (2) ninth/tenth grade students, and one (1) eighth/seventh grade student currently enrolled at their respective school for the school year 2016-2017. The team is accompanied by one (1) coach.
  - \*Note: Questions regarding the eligibility of the participants, contact us through the contact numbers previously stated.
- 3. The participating teams are required to be at the venue on or before the competition starts. (To be guided accordingly, attached herewith is a copy of the program for the said event.) Teams that will not follow the said rule will only be given a ten (10) minutes time frame to compensate for their lack of punctuality. Failure to comply will result in automatic disqualification of the team.

### **NATURE OF QUESTIONS**

- 1. The quiz show is comprised of three (3) rounds: EASY, MODERATE, AND DIFFICULT.
- Each round is comprised of twelve (12) questions. For the easy round, questions are worth 10 points each; for the moderate round, questions are worth 15 points each; and for the difficult round, questions are worth 20 points each. (These may vary according to the decision of the Contest Committee)
- The total question of 36 may come from the fields of Mathematics (Algebra, Trigonometry, Geometry, and Probability and Statistics), General Sciences, and General Information (Current Events, History, and Literature).
- 4. The questions shall be in the form of Identification, Fill-in-the-Blanks and Problem Solving.

### **CONDUCT OF THE QUIZ SHOW**

- 1. **Three contestants** per team will be allowed to compete for each round. This includes the **Team Captain** who is obliged to play throughout the duration of the quiz bee.
- Substitution of contestants will only be allowed after the easy round and the moderate round. The contestants for the final round will automatically be the ones to represent the team in case of ties.
- 3. Contestants will only be allowed to bring pencils, pens and calculators on the stage. Only non-programmable calculators will be permitted. Bringing of any paper, cellular phones and other communication devices is prohibited. Violation to this rule will disqualify the team from the quiz show. Acetates, whiteboard markers and scrap papers will be provided for each team.
- 4. Ushers will reset each calculator before the start of each round.
- 5. The quiz master will first announce the corresponding **category**, **time allotted** for computation and writing of final answer, and the **equivalent point** of each question.

- 6. Each Question will be read **twice**. The team may start solving the problem while the question is still being read. The timer will start once the quizmaster says "Timer starts now." When the allotted time has elapsed, the quizmaster will say "Time is up."
- 7. The candidates per team may discuss their answers within themselves, but the team must only write one final answer on the provided acetate. Final answers must not have any form of erasures. If the final answer has any form of erasures, the answer will be considered incorrect.
- 8. Upon the announcement of "Time is up", the acetate must be raised immediately. If a team fails to do so, it will be deemed that the team has given an incorrect answer. The ushers will then retrieve the raised acetate and surrender it to the technical booth. The answer for each team will be projected for the quiz master to read aloud and for the audience to see.
- 9. Incorrectly spelled answers will constitute a wrong answer. Questions with numerical answers must be solved without rounding off. If the numerical answer is not a whole number, the answer must be expressed in four (4) decimal places unless otherwise specified. Failure to comply will automatically make the answer incorrect.
- 10. **Proper units must also be observed.** However, if the question asks for an answer in certain units, then the magnitude without a unit is acceptable. Example: How many centimeters are there in a meter? Both the answers "100" and "100cm" are acceptable.
- 11. No deductions will be made for incorrect answers and for unanswered questions.
- 12. The total team score will be determined by summing up the scores in the easy, moderate and difficult rounds. The team that is able to attain the **highest total score** will be awarded the winner.
- 13. Ties shall be broken by sudden-death play-off. Tied teams will be asked a series of questions until the tie is completely resolved. If the tie still exists after three tie-breaking questions, the speed-play format will be followed. Teams will bid for the correct answer. The first team that will give the correct answer within the allotted time will win the tie. Once a team gives an incorrect answer, it shall automatically lose the tie.

#### **CLARIFICATIONS**

- The team captain for each participating team should always be one of the three candidates for each round. The team captain is the only one who has the right to raise a question or clarification or complaint which will be addressed by the Board of Judges.
- Questions or clarifications or complaints by any team must be raised immediately before the succeeding question is read. Otherwise, the complaint will not be entertained.
- 3. The decision of the Board of Judges will be final and irrevocable.
