

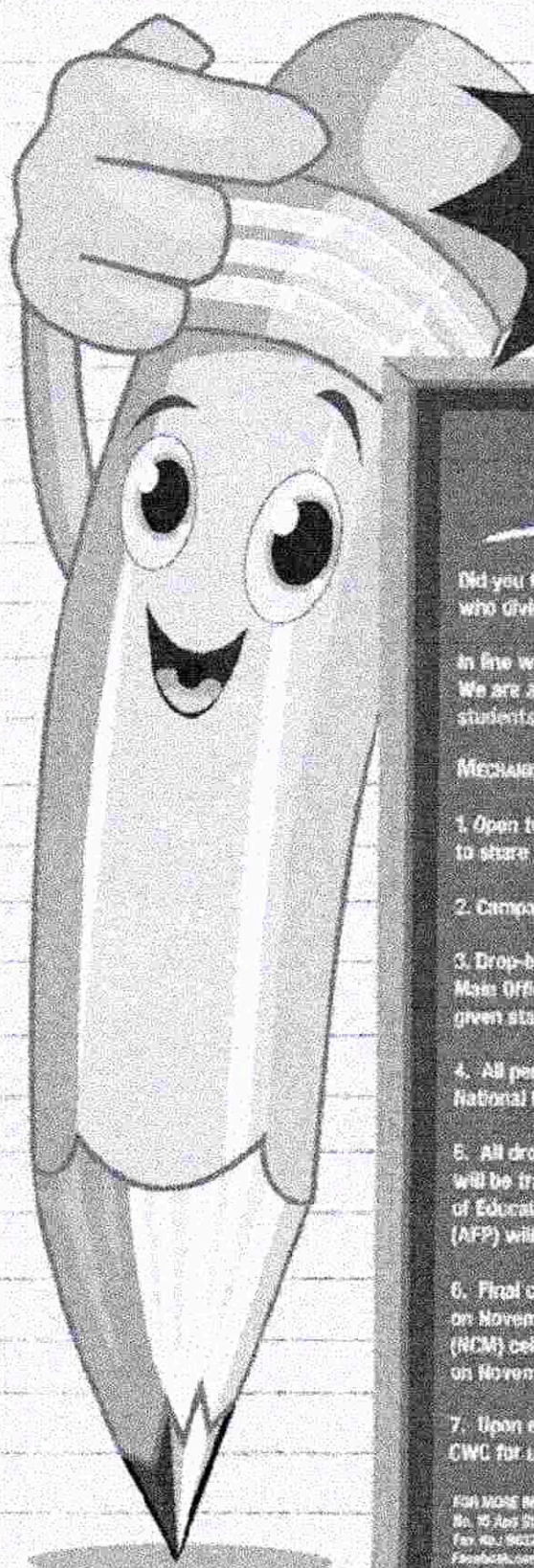
ONE MILLION LAPIS CAMPAIGN

1. In line with the National Children's Month Celebration in November, the Department of Education will be participating in the "One Million Lapis Campaign" Project as stated in the DepEd Order No. 169, s. 2016. The campaign aims to gather lapis/pencils for the benefit of our under privilege learners who lack opportunity to pursue schooling and this endeavor also envisioned to enter the Guinness Book of World Record by 2016.
2. In this connection, this office encourage all employees (teaching and Non-Teaching) to participate in the above mentioned project and have its own improvised Drop boxes. Schools may remit pencil donations to the Social Mobilization and Networking Section, School Governance and Operations Division on or before **October 24, 2016**.

Did you know that in far-flung schools there are students who divide one lapis into three in order to write and learn?

In line with the celebration of the 2016 National Children's Month, We are aiming to collect 1,000,000 pencils for underprivileged students and set a world record.

MECHANICS/ GUIDELINES:

1. Open to all individuals, groups, company and institution willing to share their Lapis.
2. Campaign runs from April until October 2016.
3. Drop-boxes will be distributed by CWC within the month of April. Main Offices of National Government Agencies and other partners will be given standard drop-boxes and make available such in their Regional Offices.
4. All pencils whether new or use can be placed in the drop-boxes located in National Government Offices, its Regional Offices and all SM Supermalls.
5. All drop-boxes will be collected every two (2) months or if already filled-up will be transported to the One Million Lapis storage at the Department of Education (DepEd) main office at ULTRA. The Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) will facilitate the collection of drop-boxes.
6. Final counting and official declaration of Lapis generated will be on November 5, 2016 as a kick-off activity of the 2016 National Children's Month (NCM) celebrations. Official turn-over of Lapis generated will be given to DepEd on November 20, 2016 as a culminating activity.
7. Upon end of the Project Campaign, all Lapis drop-boxes will be returned to CWC for use in subsequent activity.




1. The Council for the Welfare of Children (CWC) is the focal government inter-agency body mandated to formulate policies and plans, monitor the implementation and enforcement of laws to protect and promote children's rights by virtue of Presidential Decree No. 603, otherwise known as the *Child and Youth Welfare Code*. As one of the major activities of the National Children's Month this November, the Department of Education (DepEd) supports the CWC's advocacy campaign entitled, **One Million Lapis**.

2. The **One Million Lapis Campaign** aims to collect one million pencils to be given to underprivileged children in elementary schools of the 4th to 6th class municipalities of the country. These children lack the opportunity to pursue schooling and necessary materials for writing. A documentary in 2012 showed that children in far-flung villages of the country divide one pencil into three to be used for writing. Moreover, this campaign also envisions to enter the Guinness World Record for the longest line of pencils.

3. In support to this, all DepEd Offices-Central Office (CO), Regional Offices (ROs) and Schools Division Offices (SDOs) and all public and private schools in the country are hereby enjoined to participate in the campaign. All DepEd personnel and staff must be guided by DepEd Order No. 41, s. 2012 or the *No Collection Policy*. Collection of pencils must be done on a voluntary basis only and must not be mandatory nor become a school requirement.

In addition, DepEd personnel and staff may invite their partners from non-government organizations, parent-teachers associations, and other members of the community or the private sector to donate pencils for the Campaign. Donation of pencils for the Campaign will be done until **October 26, 2016**.
