

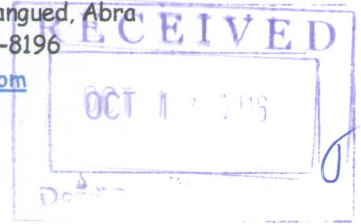

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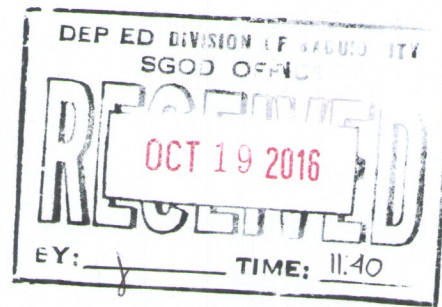

Greetings of Peace and Development!

The Concerned Citizens of Abra for Good Government (CCAGG) has an engagement with the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP)-Philippines on the Third Party Monitoring (TPM) of Department of Education (DepED) Projects located specifically in selected localities of the Cordilleras. The DepEd has a program of procurement, delivery and distributing of IT equipment (computer package) to various senior high schools nationwide and in particular to the 4 provinces of the Cordillera (Abra, Benguet, Mountain Province, Kalinga). This is in support to the schools computerization program. This TPM project will run until December 2016.

With this monitoring engagement, the CCAGG will focus on the following tasks and responsibilities:

- 1) Organize and recruit community and/or school based volunteers for deployment;
- 2) Train community and/or school based volunteers on the DepED monitoring tool using QR Codes and online survey (UNDP to provide the training to CCAGG and some volunteer coordinators)
- 3) Conduct readiness assessment of the schools to receive the computer shipment using the DepED readiness checklist;
- 4) Monitor the delivery of the computers to the various schools in CAR;
- 5) Monitor the installation of the computers by the winning bidder to determine whether the computers are in working order;
- 6) Administer citizen report card survey to school administration and students on the satisfaction and optimization of the use of computers after 1 month of delivery.


