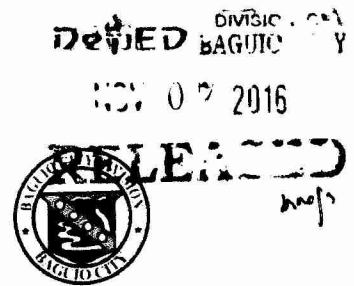

**NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS MONTH ACTIVITIES**

1. The Department of Education (DepEd), in partnership with the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), establishes the Youth for Environment in Schools Organization (YES-O) as the only recognized co-curricular environmental club or organization in the schools and consolidates all other environmental and/or ecology clubs or organizations in school with main and primary programs or projects for the environment or ecology in the said Organization. (DO 93 s. 2011). YES-O is a students' organization aimed to wake and inculcate the sense of awareness and initiative of improving the current situation of the environment. To strengthen the implementation of the YES-O Program pursuant to DepEd Order No. 93, s. 2011 (Mandated Programs, Projects and Activities, Various Forms and Targets Pertinent to the Youth for Environment in Schools Programs), there are activities stated in the observance of the nationwide celebrations on Environmental Events conducted every month of November with the theme: **Green Schools... Building Climate-Resilient and Sustainable Communities.**

3. School-based activities shall be conducted on or before November 24, 2016. Schools should adhere strictly to the contest guidelines and mechanics stipulated in this memorandum.

4. Pre-registration of contestants for the division level contest should be submitted on or before November 25, 2016 (See required form for registration) to determine number of actual participants during the Division YES-O Culminating Activity.
5. A registration fee of Fifty Pesos (Php 50.00) shall be charged from each participant and Two Hundred Pesos (Php 200.00) and Three Hundred Pesos (Php 300.00) for participants of group contest in elementary and secondary respectively to cover expenses for certificates, materials for the contest , token for judges and other operational expenses.
6. Awards and Recognition: The top three winners in each contest and category will be given certificates of recognition. Non-winners will be given certificates of participation.
7. Schools should prepare accomplishment reports and photo documentation in the conduct of their activities and submit to the Division YES-O Coordinator.
8. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

## Enclosure 1 Contest Guidelines and Mechanics

### ELEMENTARY LEVEL

#### A. On the Spot Poster-Making Contest (1 student per school)

1. Only one (1) contestant per school shall participate in the contest.
2. The contestant must be a registered member of YES-O.
3. The poster shall revolve around the theme which will be announced by the contest administrator during the contest proper.
4. The medium for visual artistry shall be oil pastel only. The required base paper to be used during the contest is 1/4 illustration board. Contestant must provide his/her own materials. Borrowing of materials from the other contestants shall not be allowed.
5. The allotted time for the contest is two (2) hours, after which all entries shall be submitted to the contest administrator. Contestant may decide to submit his/her poster earlier without waiting for the lapse of two hours.
6. Each poster shall be identified by a member that corresponds to the number and identity of the contestant for the judging process.
7. Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

Originality of idea	40%
Relevance to the theme	40%
Overall impact	20%
Total:	100%
8. The decision of the judges shall be final and unappealable.

#### B. Eco-Quiz (1 student per school)

1. Only one contestant per school will be allowed to participate in this contest.
2. English shall be used as the official language in the conduct of the quiz.
3. Questions shall focus on environmental facts, laws, current events, initiatives and other subjects pertaining to environment and ecology.
4. The contestants shall bring their own pens, answer sheet will provided by the organizers.
5. The quiz shall follow a game show scheme.
  - a. Each question shall be read twice by the quizmaster.
  - b. The contestant shall only answer as soon as the quizmaster shall have read the question twice and have so indicated their time to write the answer in big bold letters. Countdown shall start immediately thereafter.
  - c. Contestants shall be given a maximum of twenty (20) seconds to answer the questions that require computation. Other questions shall only be allotted ten (10) seconds.
  - d. Should the contestant decide to change the answer, he/she cross out the answer so written with only one horizontal line and the new answer shall be written legibly above the crossed out answer. The contestant is allowed to change the answer within the time allotted for a particular question.
  - e. The contestant shall raise their pens as soon as the time allotted time to answer is over.
6. Ten questions for easy, ten questions for average, ten questions for difficult rounds with points 1, 2, 3 respectively in different rounds in each question. In case of a tie a clincher round will be applied. The first one to answer correctly shall be declared winner over the other.
7. The decision of the judges shall be final and unappealable.

### C. Interpretative Dance

1. A minimum of six (6) to eight (8) participants per school shall perform during the contest.
2. The presentation should last for a maximum of five (5) minutes, in which period shall be included the entrance and the exit of the performers.
3. The presentation must be environment related interpretative dance.
4. May use any music of their choice. However, music must have lyrics.
5. Props should be at the minimum only. Contestant shall wear creative costumes using recycled materials
6. Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

Mastery, Execution and Choreography	30%
Musicality and Effective Use of Props and Costume	30%
Concept/Interpretation/	30%
Audience Impact	10%
Total:	<b>100%</b>
7. Decisions of the board of judges are final and unappealable.

1. Participants are required to bring their own scrap materials needed for their output.
2. Each participant should make a TITLE of his/her artwork and write a simple description about it.
3. The allotted time for the workshop/hands-on is two hours, after which all entries shall be submitted to the organizers.

## SECONDARY LEVEL

### FOR JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL

#### A. Extemporaneous Speech (English, 1 student per school/ Filipino, 1 student per school)

1. One (1) representative per school shall participate.
2. A topic/question shall be picked by the participants.
3. Contestants will be given 5 minutes to prepare their speeches.
4. Contestants will speak one at a time. The speech should be delivered within 5 -7 minutes.
5. Exceeding the time limit will draw a penalty.
6. Impromptu shall be delivered in English/Filipino.
7. Form of Delivery could be conversational, debate, oratorical or discussion type.
8. Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

Speech development	30%
Speech value	20%
Delivery	30%
Appropriate Language	10%
Correctness of Language	10%
Total	100%

#### B. Essay Writing Contest (English, 1 student per school/ Filipino, 1 student per school)

1. Only one contestant per school will be allowed to participate in this contest.
2. It shall be an on-the-spot essay writing contest. As such, the theme/topic shall be announced during the contest proper.
3. The essay must be written in English, consisting of not less than 200 words but not more than 300 words, handwritten on a yellow pad paper provided by the organizers with one-inch margins on all sides.
4. Yellow papers will be provided by the organizers.
5. Participant per school should bring their own black ball pen.
6. Contestants may decide to submit his/her essay earlier without waiting for the lapse of one and a half (1 ½ hrs)
7. Criteria for judging shall be based on the following:

Content	40%
Relevance to the theme	30%
Unity/ Organization of Idea	15%
Grammar	15%
Total:	100%

8. Decision of judges is final and unappealable.

#### C. Eco-Quiz (1 student per school)

1. Only one contestant per school will be allowed to participate in this contest.
2. English shall be used as the official language in the conduct of the quiz.
3. Questions shall focus on environmental facts, laws, current events, initiatives and other subjects pertaining to environment and ecology.
4. The contestants shall bring their own pens, answer sheet will provided by the organizers.
5. The quiz shall follow a game show scheme.
  - a. Each question shall be read twice by the quizmaster.
  - b. The contestant shall only answer as soon as the quizmaster shall have read the question twice and have so indicated their time to write the answer in big bold letters. Countdown shall start immediately thereafter.
  - c. Contestants shall be given a maximum of twenty (20) seconds to answer the questions that require computation. Other questions shall only be allotted ten (10) seconds.
  - d. Should the contestant decide to change the answer, he/she cross out the answer so written with only one horizontal line and the new answer shall be written legibly above the

crossed out answer. The contestant is allowed to change the answer within the time allotted for a particular question.

- e. The contestant shall raise their pens as soon as the time allotted time to answer is over.
- 6. Ten questions for easy, ten questions for average, ten questions for difficult rounds with points 1, 2, 3 respectively in different rounds in each question. In case of a tie a clincher round will be applied. The first one to answer correctly shall be declared winner over the other.
- 7. The decision of the judges shall be final and unappealable.

**D. Sayawit para sa Kalikasan ( 15 to 20 students per school)**

- 1. A minimum of fifteen (15) to twenty (20) participants shall perform during the contest.
- 2. Dancers and singers are considered as performers.
- 3. The performance must consist of a song and dance presentation on the environment. Participants must actually sing and dance at the same time. Any song in English, Filipino or any dialect may be used or a combination thereof may be utilized.
- 4. The presentation should last for a maximum of five (5) minutes, in which period shall be included the introduction and the exit of the performers.
- 5. The presentation shall be stopped when time is up.
- 6. Musical accompaniment for the presentation should compact disc generated only. No live accompaniment shall be allowed.
- 7. The presentation must have environmental relevance and significance.
- 8. Props should be at the minimum only. Contestant shall wear creative costumes using recycled materials and should be brought to school after the event.
- 9. Only one group shall represent a school.
- 10. Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

Environmental Relevance/Message/Implication	30%
Voice Quality/ Clarity of the delivery of the piece	20%
Precision of Dance Movements( Mastery/Coordination)	20%
Originality/ Costume/ Props	20%
Projection and overall impact (Stage Presence)	10%
Total:	<b>100%</b>
- 11. Decisions of the board of judges are final and unappealable.

**FOR SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL**

**A. Debate (3 STUDENTS PER SCHOOL –TEAM)**

- 1. Three (3) participants shall comprise a team.
- 2. Each team shall make an argumentative essay on both the AFFIRMATIVE (AFF) and NEGATIVE (NEG) sides of a given motion. The medium to be used will be in English.
- 3. In arguing for the AFF and NEG, the following must be presented in the essay.
  - AFF Stand and at least three well-constructed cases/situations/examples to forward the stand taken, answering the Benefit, Necessity ad Practicability of the Stand.
  - NEG Stand and at least three well-constructed cases/situations/examples to forward the stand taken, answering the Benefit, Necessity ad Practicability of the Stand.
- 4. The essays will be evaluated based on the following:

MATTER	40% (The components are logical and relevance)
METHOD	20% (The components are responsiveness and structure)
- 5. After the judging for the case-building speech/essays, two (2) teams will fight for the Manner battle referred as the 7-minute challenge. This will test the team's ability to speak out their ideas using the case-building speech/essay which they have made.
- 6. Teams will be given three (3) minutes to prepare for a group speech of 7 minutes. The members will decide in the team split. They will decide who will open the speech, who will

do the speech on Benefits, Necessity and Practicability and who gets to conclude the speech.

7. The scoring for MANNER will be between 0-40% which will be added to their previous scores on Matter and Method.
8. There will only be two teams who will qualify for the Final Round.
9. A new motion will be given thirty minutes (30) before the final round.
10. The final round will take the form of an informal debate with guest moderators. Each team, however, must have a team split (Benefit, Necessity, and Practicability). Judging shall be based on Matter, Method, and Manner.
11. Decision of judges is final and unappealable.

**B. Infographics**

1. One (1) contestant per school.
2. Contestant must bring his/her own laptop, mouse extension wire.
3. The participant shall create an infographic based on the theme, which shall be given during the contest proper.
4. The contestant shall use ADOBE PHOTOSHOP/ COREL DRAW
5. The infographic must be:
  - a. 12" x 18" size
  - b. Portrait
  - c. Resolution 300 pixels; 8 BIT
  - d. Include the official logo of DepEd National, DepEd Baguio City, DENR, YES-O
  - e. Convert into JPEG
6. After finishing the infographics, each participant shall upload his/her art work to the official YES-O Facebook Page with his/ her name.

**C. Photo Environmental Exhibit (1 student per school)**

1. One (1) entry per school shall participate
2. Digital SLR and digital shoot camera are allowed to be used during the contest.
3. The photo must comply with the following:
  - a. The photo must focus on environment
  - b. The photo must be taken after registration
  - c. The camera must activate the date and time setting to appear on the photo
4. The photos will be displayed in the exhibit area with respective contestants to explain in the front of the panel of judges the clear and identifiable message in the photo within three-minute time. Overtime should be deducted 1% per minute from the overall grade of the entry.
5. The contest coordinator shall assign one official developing center for the contestant to develop their own photo in 8R (8"x11") size.
6. Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

Creativity	40%
Message	30%
Impact	20%
Technical Compliance	10%
Total	100%
