1. Pursuant to DepEd Advisory 265, s. 2016 and the Regional Memo no. 291 entitled "2016 Regional EsP, Sayawit, Tagis-Talino & Poster-Making Competition & Awarding of Outstanding Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao Teacher". The Regional Competition will be at NEAP-R, DepEd, CAR, Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet on November 22, 2016. In this connection, the Division of Baguio City," will conduct a number of activities for this month EsP celebration with the theme: "Ang Kabataang Pilipino sa Gitna ng Globalisasyon".
2. The objectives are:
 - a. To enhance the innovativeness and creativity among EsP learners in the division through the competitions.
 - b. To assess the mastery level of learners on the competencies learned in EsP.
 - c. To display the value of unity, sportsmanship and friendly skills exhibition among learners.

4. CRITERIA AND MECHANICS FOR THE DIFFERENT CONTESTS

A. Rules of the Contest – TAGIS TALINO

1. The teams will compete in the Easy (1 pt), Average (3pts), and the Difficult (5pts) categories.
2. There will be 10 questions per category that relate to the contents of EsP 7, 8, 9 & 10.
3. The quizmaster will read the question twice and the team will be given 15 seconds to write the answer on the answer sheet the wait for the quizmaster's signal to raise their answers. The scores will check the answers and tally the scores on the scoreboard.
4. The three teams with the highest scores will be declared as winners. (Champion, 1st runner up, and 2nd runner up)
5. In case of a tie, the quizmaster will ask a new set of three questions. The team with the highest score will automatically be declared as the winner.

B. Rules of the Contest – SAYAWIT**(ELEMENTARY DIVISION (Grades 4-6), SECONDARY DIVISION (Grades 7-10))**

1. Sayawit presentation must be relevant to the convention theme.
2. Presentation time should not exceed 10 minutes excluding entrance, exit, and other preparations for stage.
3. Number of performers on stage should be from 7-10 (singers and dancers) excluding technical assistants, who are singing and dancing at the same time.
4. Contestants may use props and other stage sets.
5. Live accompaniment is required, and no lip-synchs.
6. Costumes must be appropriate to the movements.

Criteria for Judging

1. Concept and relevance to the theme	30%
2. Choreography	25%
3. Musicality	25%
4. Props and costumes	10%
5. Over-all staging Impact	10%

C. Rules of the Contest – On-The-Spot POSTER-MAKING**(ELEMENTARY DIVISION (Grades 4-6), SECONDARY DIVISION (Grades 7-10))**

1. Contestants are advised to bring their own materials.
 - a. ¼ illustration board, pencil, pastel/craypass
2. Contestants are given 3 hours to finish the work.
3. Letterings and borders are not allowed as part of the presentation.

Criteria for Judging

1. Relevance to the theme	30%
2. Creativity	25%
3. Originality	25%
4. Visual Impact	20%
