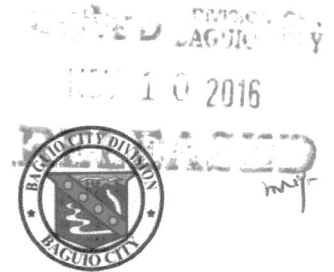

If interested, kindly send your nominations on or before **November 11, 2016**. Qualified are high performing high potential personnel occupying permanent positions: SG-18 to SG-24.

The Public Management Development Program (PMDP) is the Philippine government's response to the need for a corps of ethical, competent, committed and development-oriented officials in the bureaucracy who will drive performance in the agencies and push the agenda for change and sustained progress.

The Program has a five-month residential training at DAP Tagaytay with regular one week breaks which is followed by the implementation of a Re-entry Project (ReP) addressing concern or issue of their agencies. Academic achievements such as a Certificate of Residential Training Competition, Diploma in Development Management and Master in Development Management are granted by DAP upon completion of program milestones.
