3. **Requirements and Fee:**

Each applicant must submit his/her :

- a. Duly accomplished application form
- b. Two (2) latest and identical 2" x 2" pictures with name tag
- c. Photocopy of Grade VI Report Card duly certified correct by the Elementary Principal OR bring the original copy of Report Card together with a photocopy to be certified by the BCHS Guidance Counselor


#### **Grade requirement (Third Grading Period)**

- d. A general average of 83 % or higher and no grade lower than 80 % in any subject
- d. Two Hundred Pesos examination fee for test materials, honorarium and other incidental expenses

4. **Areas:**

a	<b>DANCE</b>	Develops learner's techniques, movement, vocabulary and a deeper understanding of dance as a form of communication and expression.
b	<b>DIGITAL ARTS</b>	Teaches learners to use elements and tools of current and emerging technologies to create works that express feelings and ideas; learners will be trained to analyze and create work through photography, video, audio, computer arts, interactive media and film production.
c	<b>THEATER ARTS</b>	Emphasizes on group work skills and live performance of spoken text in a number of styles and genres; contemporary and classical acting techniques will be introduced.
d	<b>VISUAL ARTS</b>	Helps learners discover what they can produce through their own creativity through paintings, printmaking, creative crafts and designs, computer graphics, sculpture, etc.
e	<b>LITERARY ARTS (English &amp; Filipino)</b>	Train learners to explore and write their own ideas and experiences; they will study and work on all genres like poetry, fiction, non-fiction, etc.
f	<b>MUSIC : Vocal/Choir Band Rondalla</b>	Designed for dedicated music learners with interest in vocal or instrumental music <b>Band Instruments :</b> Flute, Trumpets, Altosax, Clarinets, Tenor Sax, Trombones, Percussion/Drums <b>Rondalla Instruments :</b> Violin, Guitar, Banduria, Octavina, Bass

5. **Filing Period** starts on February 1, 2017 at Baguio City High School Guidance Services Office. Walk-in applicants with complete requirements will be accepted on test day from 7:00AM - 7:45AM.
6. **Individual Filing** by the learner or parent/guardian.
7. **Results of the examinations** shall be posted in the school bulletin board.
