
The University will be hosting the event on February 18, 2017 where winning groups shall receive:



ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS, PROTESTS & OTHER MATTERS

1. The contest is open to Grade 9-10 students only.
2. All participants should be officially enrolled for the SY 2016-2017.
3. **Complete & Final list of participants and coaches** from respective schools should be submitted on or before **February 10, 2017 (6PM)**. For a more organized flow of events, we are imploring all schools to submit their **Audio CD** on or before **February 16, 2017 (6PM)**.
4. Protests are prohibited and will not be accepted regarding any score or result of a decision. The decision of the judge/s is final and irrevocable and no contestants shall contact in any way or manner any of the judges in connection with ratings or critiques.

OFFICIAL RANKING AND PRIZES:

- All participants and coaches shall receive certificates of participation
- Ranking & Prizes:
 - **SPECIAL PRIZE - Best UB Jingle Choreography: Php 2,000**
 - 4th Runner Up: Trophy, Certificate, & Php 2,000
 - 3rd Runner Up: Trophy, Certificate, & Php 3,000
 - 2nd Runner Up: Trophy, Certificate, & Php 4,000
 - 1st Runner Up: Trophy, Certificate, & Php 5,000
 - Champion: Trophy, Certificate, Php 6,000, & 32" LED TV (for school)

HIP-HOP COMPETITION DETAILS:

1. Each school is entitled to send one (1) entry. Schools are open to invite as many guests and supporters during the event.
2. Each group shall have a minimum of six (6) and a maximum of fifteen (15) members. A **one (1) point deduction** per judge will be applied if the group will not be able to conform to the minimum/maximum number of members.
3. Performance (including set-up and set-down of props) should be rendered within seven (7) minutes. A 0.2 points for every second of overtime will be deducted from the score given per judge if the performers will not be able to conform with the maximum time.
4. Medley and remixes are allowed.
5. **A part of the UB Jingle should be incorporated in the group's music.** Special prize shall be given to the group with the best UB JINGLE choreography.



6. Floor routine is very much encouraged. The University shall not be liable for any accidents brought about by dangerous dance steps and stunts of the performers.
7. For a more organized flow of events, we are imploring all schools to submit their **Audio CD** on or before **February 16, 2017**.
