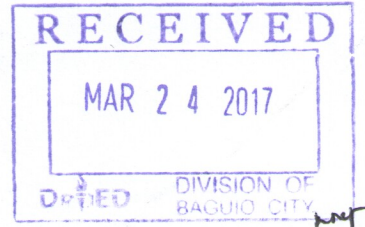

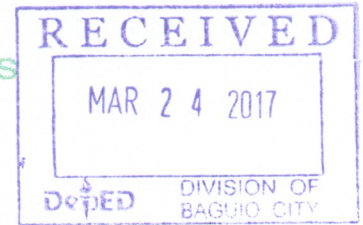

Camper's Qualifications:

Girls

Adults

1. Must be a duly registered Troop Leader
2. She must be able to live by the GS promise and law.
3. Must be emotionally stable and physically fit with Medical Certificate.

Things to Bring:

For Individuals (Travel Light):

1. Complete Official Uniforms (please refer to Dress Code)
2. 2 Logo shirts
3. jeans (maong), jogging pants
4. Under wears, towel
5. swimsuit for your water safety
6. Pen, personal effects & toiletries
7. Rubber slippers, sit upon
8. Rubber shoes/sneakers
9. Light rain jacket, umbrella
10. Sleeping bag/bedroll and beddings
11. Prescribed medicines
12. camera (optional)
13. Flashlight insect repellent/suntan lotion
14. Bolo/camping knife

For Patrols:

1. Water Jug/container
2. Pail/bucket
3. First Aid kit
4. Garbage bags for 3 days
5. Fire woods/charcoal for 3 days Cooking your food
6. Bamboo/sticks for your gadgets (tri pad, shoe rock, table and others)
7. string for making your gadgets
8. all utensils to be used is made out of woods, coconut shells.
9. 3 eggs per camper (to be submitted on April 7)
10. 1 bunch of Dip-ping banana
11. Match/lighter
