DIVISION ORIENTATION AND TRAINING ON THE DRUG TESTING PROGRAM

To: Division Chiefs
Public School District Supervisors
School heads
Division Unit Heads
School Anti-Drug Abuse Coordinators/Teachers
All Others Concerned

- In line with the directive of DepEd Secretary Leonor M. Briones on protecting learners from the
 adverse effects of dangerous drugs, and in support to the anti-drug campaign of President Rodrigo
 Roa Duterte, there will be an orientation and training on the conduct of mandatory drug testing
 for division officials and personnel; and for the random drug testing in schools.
 The training program will be held on August 2-4, 2017, at Prince Plaza Hotel, Baguio City.
- 2. The training aims to:
 - a. Orient all division personnel, school heads and coordinators on the Drug Testing Program of the Department of Education, the provisions of RA 9165, and other DEpEd issuances.
 - Refocus every anti-illegal drugs program on the three components: curriculum and instruction, co-curricular initiatives, and drug education and drug testing program.
 - c. Clarify the purpose of drug testing among personnel, teachers, students, and stakeholders according to the Dangerous Drugs Board regulations.
 - d. Understand better the division intervention program, the Enhanced My School, My Home program in response to the call of protecting children in school.
 - e. Identify members of the Selection Board in preparation for the conduct of the Drug testing. For more information, all concerned may contact Mrs. Brendalee C. awingan, PSDS-CID, Division Office with CP NO. 09360248175.
