1. DepEd-Division of Baguio City, Social Mobilization Unit-Division Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DDRRM) will celebrate the 2017 July National Disaster Resilience Month (NDRM) by undertaking various activities relative to disaster resilience covering the four thematic areas of DRRM namely: Disaster Prevention and Mitigation, Disaster Preparedness, Disaster Response and Disaster Rehabilitation and Recovery.
2. This year's NDRM theme is "4Ks: **Kamalayan sa Kahandaan, Katumbas ay Kaligtasan**".

A. FIRE SAFETY SKILL COMPETITION

I. QUALIFICATION/ REQUIREMENTS

a. ADULT/ TEACHERS CATEGORY

➤ Participants must be composed of 12 members per team. Each District in the Elementary and High School must create one team to participate.

- 1 PTA (Division wide)
- 1 DepEd Div. DRRM team (DepEd Division Office)
- 10 District Teams (District)

➤ Participants must be a permanent or contractual employee of the Department of Education.

➤ The PTA must be duly certified member of the Federation.

➤ Must be physically fit to accept the challenge.

b. JUNIOR HIGH CATEGORY

➤ Participants must be composed of 12 members. Each school must create one team to participate.

c. SENIOR HIGH CATEGORY

➤ Participants must be composed of 12 members. Each school must create one team to participate.

d. ELEMENTARY CATEGORY

➤ Participants must be composed of 12 members. Each school must create one team participant

II. MNEMONICS

a. Each team shall have 12 members.

b. All contestant members must have a valid PRC Membership with Accidental Assistance Benefit (MAAB).

c. Team members are **preferred** to be 10 boys and 2 girls, however, **this is only preferential** and would not mean any technicalities that may result in disqualification. This preference is in line with the thrust of the DepEd for gender balance and equality.

d. Problems/scenarios are from consultation with Baguio City Bureau of Fire.

III. QUALIFICATION/ REQUIREMENTS

- a. ADULT/ TEACHERS CATEGORY
 - Participants must be composed of 10 members per team. Each District in the Elementary and High School must create one team to participate.
 - 1 PTA (Division wide)
 - 1 DepEd Div. DRRM team (DepEd Division Office)
 - 10 District SDRRM Teams (District)
 - Participants must be a permanent or contractual employee of the Department of Education.
 - PTA must be duly certified member of the Federation.
 - Must be physically fit to accept the challenge.
- b. JUNIOR HIGH CATEGORY
 - Participants must be composed of 10 members. Each school must create one team to participate.
- c. SENIOR HIGH CATEGORY
 - Participants must be composed of 10 members. Each school must create one team to participate.

IV. MNEMONICS

- a. Each team shall have 10 members.
- b. All contestant members must have a valid PRC Membership with Accidental Assistance Benefit (MAAB) .
- c. Team members are **preferred** to be 5 boys and 5 girls, however, **this is only preferential** and would not mean any technicalities that may result to disqualification. This preference is in line with the trust of the DepEd for gender balance and equality.
- d. Problems/scenarios will be prepared by the Baguio City Emergency Medical Services /City Disaster DRRM Council

**C. 2017 QUIZ BEE ON
DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT (DRRM)**

1. Only **one contestant per school** will be allowed to participate in this contest.

Categories:

- a. ELEMENTARY LEVEL (Grade 1-6)
- b. JUNIOR SECONDARY LEVEL (Grade 7-10)

2. English shall be used as the official language in the conduct of the quiz.

3. Questions shall focus on disaster risk reduction management and other subjects pertaining to environment.

4. The contestants shall bring their own pens, answer sheet will be provided by the organizers.

5. The quiz shall follow a game show scheme.

- a. All questions shall be taken from DepEd DRRM Manuals, RA 10121 and other DRRM related topics/issues.
- b. Each question shall be read twice by the quizmaster.
- c. The contestant shall only answer as soon as the quizmaster shall have read the question twice and have so indicated their time to write the answer in big bold letters. Countdown shall start immediately thereafter.
- d. Contestants shall be given a maximum of twenty (20) seconds to answer the questions that require computation. Other questions shall only be allotted ten (10) seconds.
- e. Should the contestant decide to change the answer, he/she cross out the answer so written with only one horizontal line and the new answer shall be written legibly above the crossed out answer. The contestant is allowed to change the answer within the time allotted for a particular question.
- f. The contestant shall raise their pens as soon as the time allotted time to answer is over.

6. Ten questions for easy, ten questions for average, ten questions for difficult rounds with points 1, 2, 3 respectively in different rounds in each question. In case of a tie a clincher round will be applied. The first one to answer correctly shall be declared winner over the other.

7. The decision of the judges shall be final and unappeasable.

D. DIASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT SHORT FILM CONTEST
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MECHANICS:

1. Junior High students are invited for the DepEd DRRM Short Film contest.
2. The theme: "**4Ks: Kamalayan sa Kahandaan, Katumbas ay Kaligtasan**". will be the guiding plot for the DepEd DRRM Short Film to be submitted.
3. There will be 4 categories:
 - a. Bomb threat or Fire Prevention
 - b. Earthquake
 - c. Typhoon
 - d. Landslide
4. Submitted short films will be included as an instructional and educational material by the Division Disaster Risk Reduction and Management and the City Government of Baguio – City Disaster Risk Reduction Management Council in informing students and teachers the community to be prepared against all hazard present in our locality.
5. School may submit One entry for each 4 categories
6. Each videos will be represented by:
 - a. Director
 - b. Editor
 - c. Scriptwriter
 - d. Coach/ Teacher Supervisor
7. there will be no limitations in the number of Actors/ Actress as long as they are duly certified students of their respective school.
8. Entries should be submitted on September 6, 2017, 5:00 PM in an envelope, the video copied in a CD in MP4/WMV/MPEG format with an entry form

A. CONTENT/VIDEO

1. 8 to 10 minutes' video- main content
2. 2 seconds title, cast, school at the last part
3. All sounds/music that will be used should be under creative common license or original composition
4. All videos should be original
5. Subtitle should be added is language used if not Filipino or English
6. All scene should be taken in Baguio City
7. No showing of characters being portrayed smoking, drinking liquor, use of drugs, physical harm to other person or animals, use of foul language and degrading situation is prohibited

B. VIDEO-MAKING

1. Students creativity should be maximized; we encourage minimal adult supervision in conceptualization and shooting.
2. Judges decision will be final
