**ORDINANCE Numbered 62
(Series of 2017)**

**MANDATING ALL PRIVATE AND PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHING AND
NON-TEACHING PERSONNEL TO UNDERGO RISK REDUCTION
TRAINING.**

Explanatory Note

The 1987 Philippine Constitution mandates the State to protect and promote the right of the people to basic health services, and instill health consciousness among them. The enactment of Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction Management Act of 2010, recognizes the necessity of being prepared for the eventuality of any disaster, natural or man-made, in order to prevent or lessen its after-effects.

Recently, the Province of Surigao was struck by a magnitude 6.7. earthquake that claimed six (6) lives, injuring many, destroying homes, buildings, and schools thus leaving thousands of families in peril.

After the occurrence of calamities like flashfloods, earthquakes and even fire, some schools are occasionally used as evacuation centers after a disaster. Trainings and seminars should be conducted to the faculty members of private and public schools, since majority of the children and youth are inside campuses during daytime, should any disaster or emergency occur.

The parents of the abovementioned students will feel a lot safer knowing that when it comes to emergency situations, the faculty are properly trained to provide immediate patient care. Alongside the Barangay Emergency Response Team, the City Government can now count on the school faculty members to support the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council, making it more efficient and responsive to the needs that may arise.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Olowan and Hon. Fianza, seconded by Hon. Bomogao, Hon. Allad-iw, Hon. Yangot, Hon. Alangsab, and Hon. Fariñas,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD (CITY COUNCIL) IN
SESSION ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. TITLE. – This ordinance shall be known as “**MANDATING ALL PRIVATE**

SECTION 2. BASIS. – It is the policy of the City Government of Baguio to be firmly committed to the protection and promotion of the health and safety of all its residents.

SECTION 3. PARTY. – All private and public teaching and non-teaching personnel shall undergo regular Risk Reduction Training.


SECTION 4. IMPLEMENTATION AND MONITORING. – The City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council is hereby tasked to conduct safety training and seminars and monitor the effective implementation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE. – All public and private schools are hereby given six (6) months from the date of its passage, to comply with this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. – This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991, as amended.
