From then on, we have continued to serve the communities, and have drawn many teachers and students from different parts of the country. Hence, it made our museum a popular learning institution and an alternative classroom. This is also aligned to the DepEd's thrust on Indigenous People's Education (IPED) for the K-12 program and have facilitated the significant learning about the cultures of the indigenous communities in the Cordillera.

The *Museo Kordilyera* is UP Baguio's offer to the region, and the nation. It's mission is to cultivate an understanding of and respect for the identity and culture of the indigenous peoples of the Cordillera and Northern Luzon as an integral part of the evolving Filipino culture. As an ethnographic museum, it is a repository of the tangible and intangible culture of the Cordillera, and will be distinguished by its integral connection to the scholarly activities and output of the faculty from the different colleges of the University of the Philippines in Baguio. Hence, the museum is a vital *learning center, a living museum and a pedagogical resource* for many of our teachers, scholars, and students from the Cordillera and beyond. It has become a platform for dialogue with communities in the wider world through themed exhibitions, symposia, lecture series, visual presence in the website, cultural performances, and demonstration of knowledge and skills of local artisans and cultural bearers from Cordillera and other ethno-linguistic groups.

In line with this, we would appreciate if DepEd can circulate the information about Museo Kordilyera to interested schools in CAR to visit our museum. We have a minimum of P30 for entrance fees for students, and discounted rates for group tours. The museum is open on Tuesdays-Sundays from 9:00am to 5:00pm.
