

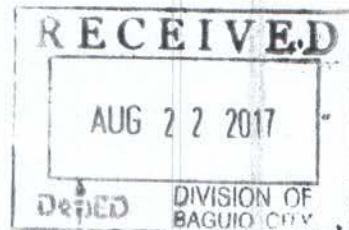

The round metal gong of the Cordillera known locally as “gangsá” is a symbol of the upland people’s culture that has been passed on from gen to another.
The profile of a person blowing a “tangguyub” represents a community being called for an important matter or action.
The lines that shape the mountains, the rice terraces, clouds and rivers symbolize the connectivity and flow of human interaction in a geogra area such as the Cordillera.
All the symbols combined represent unity and harmony of its people with culture and environment in beating the gong for self determination.

DANGEROUS DRUG ABUSE PREVENTION AND TREATMENT PROGRAM
QUIZ BEE for Public Secondary Level
Baguio City

GENERAL RULES:

1. The contest is open to students in the Public secondary level
2. Each entry is composed of 1 participant only per district and one coach
3. The Public secondary schools will have four (4) contestant representing their own district
4. Contestants must wear their school I.D
5. Contestant must be in the venue 30 minutes before the start of the contest for final instruction
6. The coverage of the quiz bee is on Dangerous Drug (ill effects, Dangerous Drug Board , Executive Orders)

PROPER MECHANICS:

1. In case the District contestant fails to come, no replacement shall be allowed.
2. Coaches are not allowed to go near the contestant seat
3. The Quiz Master/Host will read each question twice .
4. Questions shall come in Multiple Choice
5. The quiz be is divided into three level
 - a. Easy (10 questions, 1 point each)
 - b. Average (10 questions, 2 points each)
 - c. Difficult (10 questions, 3 points each)
6. No elimination is given for each round
7. Participant is given 20 seconds time to answer each question for the easy round, 40 seconds for the average round and 1 minute for the difficult round
8. Participants must write their answers using CAPITAL LETTERS only. Misspelled answers are rendered wrong
9. The official timekeeper will signal the end of time allotted for answering the question. Quizmaster will announce "TIME IS UP" and participants are required to raise their flashcard.
10. Once the answers have been checked. The Quiz Master/Host will announce the correct answers
11. In case of tie, a tie breaker question shall be given and the winner will be determined in a first-to-score basis.
12. The cumulative score for all the rounds will be the basis for selecting the winners.
13. The winner shall be declares as champion, 1st runner-up, 2nd runner-up, 3rd runner-up respectively.
