SUBJECT: 50th Anniversary of ASEAN

DATE: AUGUST 8, 2017

This is with reference to the DepEd Memorandum 3 S.2017 disseminating the Civil Service Commission Memorandum Circular No.6, s. 2016 on the Awareness Campaign in Support of ASEAN Community 2015 and the Philippines' Chairmanship of ASEAN 2017.

Aside from the regular singing of the ASEAN WAY and the hoisting of the ASEAN Flag, the Division will conduct different competitions for the celebration of the ASEAN Golden Anniversary on August 29, 2017, 8:30 AM at the Division Office Conference Hall.

The different competitions are:

1. Quiz Bee
2. Poster Making Contest
3. Essay Writing
4. Extemporaneous Speech

There are other suggested activities which can be done in the schools such as: Video- making, Speech Choir, Film Showing, Food Fest and Forum.

The guidelines, mechanics and criteria for judging in the competition are hereby attached for your guidance.

The celebration should be in line with the theme for the Philippines' Chairmanship: "Partnering for Change, Engaging the World." Under the Philippine Chairmanship, the following are the 6 thematic thrusts:

1. A people –oriented and people- centered ASEAN
2. Peace and stability in the region
3. Maritime, Security and Cooperation
4. Inclusive, Innovation- led growth
5. Resilient ASEAN
6. ASEAN: A model of regionalism, a global player

It is requested that all schools will submit their celebration report on August 25, 2017 at the Division Office c/o MARINA D. TABANGCURA, Ph.D.

Also, the School Coordinators of Araling Panlipunan both in Elementary and Secondary will have their Election of Officers and Meeting on August 11, 2017, 3:30 PM at Quezon Elem. School.

Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is desired.



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MECHANICS FOR THE QUIZ BEE

1. The coverage of the quiz is about **ASEAN** and the Philippines' Chairmanship of ASEAN 2017.
2. One participant from grade 7 or Grade 8, private or public school. (No District Elimination for this event)
3. During the quiz, participants will be provided with writing materials.
4. English will be used as the official language in the conduct of the quiz.
5. Participants will be given a total number of twenty (20) questions, of which seven (7) are Easy, seven (7) are average and six (6) are difficult.
6. Points for every correct answer will be given as follows
 - One (1) point for each easy question
 - Two (2) points for each average question
 - Three (3) points for each difficult question
7. Participants will be given ten (10) seconds to answer each question.
8. The Quizmaster will only read each question twice. Countdown will start after the question has been read the second time.
9. Top three (3) winners will be proclaimed based on cumulative scoring. The winners and their coaches will be receiving certificates.
10. All ties shall be broken by a tie breaker question from the difficult category.
11. In case of a protest or inquiry during the actual quiz proceedings, the following procedures shall be observed.
 - Only the official coach of the participant is allowed to raise a protest or inquiry at the earliest appropriate time during the quiz.
 - The protest or inquiry shall be addressed orally to the Chair of the Board of Judges who will recognize then protest or inquiry.
 - The chair will announce the decision upon deliberation with the members of the Board of Judges.

MECHANICS FOR THE POSTER MAKING CONTEST

1. The participants are coming from Grade 7 or Grade 8, public or private schools.
2. Only the top Three (3) winners from the District Elimination are qualified to join the POSTER MAKING CONTEST.
3. The schools of the District Winners will provide the materials of the participants. One fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) illustration Board, oil pastel, and pencil will be used in the contest.
4. All the contestants will be given one hour to complete their works.
5. Contestants should not be writing their names in their artworks. A code number shall be provided to each contestant as his/ her entry number.
6. Coaches are not allowed to go near the contestants.
7. The Poster shall be judged based on the following criteria:

Originality -----	20%
VISUAL Impact -----	30%
Relevance to the Theme-	30%
Neatness -----	<u>20%</u>
Total -----	100%

50th Anniversary of ASEAN ESSAY WRITING CONTEST

General Rules

1. The division essay writing contest, in celebration of the ASEAN golden anniversary, is about the awareness campaign in support of ASEAN Community 2015 and the Philippine's Chairmanship of ASEAN 2017.
2. Competing students must arrive at the venue fifteen (15) minutes before the contest proper. The students and coaches are required to bring their student IDs on the day of the contest and this must be presented at the registration table. Proper decorum shall be observed while the contest is ongoing, as well as around the venue's premises. Participants and coaches are requested to turn off their cellular phones or put them in silent mode. The contestants are not allowed to bring cellular phones and study aids during the contest proper. Contestants should come in their official school uniform.
3. The said contest is open to students currently enrolled either in public or private Secondary/Junior High School, Grades 7 or 8, for SY 2017- 2018. Each district is limited to three entries only, hence, can conduct its own elimination round prior to the division level.
4. Students may write on ASEAN related issues under the theme of **"Partnering for Change, Engaging the World"**. Entries must be written in English with a minimum of 200 and maximum of 300 words or 3-5 paragraphs. Writing materials will be provided and the participants are given an hour to work on their essays.

Submission

5. Participants are required to include the following information:
 - A. contestant's name and coach, school and contact detail during registration
 - B. given number/code only and title of the essay on the entry

Selection Criteria

6. The essay should be an original work and the contestant will be held accountable on any issues that may arise with regard to the originality and authenticity of the essay.
7. The essay will be judged according to the following criteria:
 - relevance (theme) and content (insightful substance/essence of ideas)=45%
 - writing technique/style=30%
 - grammar and structure=15%
 - overall impact=10%100% (total)
8. All entries will be judged by the one/s in charge of the essay writing contest.
9. The one/s in charge will also be awarding certificates to the students who wrote the best essays on the ASEAN-related theme on the basis of 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners. Certificates will also be distributed to participants, including coaches/teachers who assisted.

Announcement of Winners

10. The decision of the panel of the board of judges will be deemed final. Results will be based on the decision of the board of judges and to be announced during the awarding ceremony.

50th Anniversary of ASEAN EXTEMPORANEOUS SPEECH

General Guidelines

1. The division extemporaneous speech contest, in celebration of the ASEAN golden anniversary, is about the awareness campaign in support of ASEAN Community 2015 and the Philippine's Chairmanship of ASEAN 2017.
2. Competing students must arrive at the venue fifteen (15) minutes before the contest proper. The students and coaches are required to bring their student IDs on the day of the contest and this must be presented at the registration table. Proper decorum shall be observed while the contest is ongoing, as well as around the venue's premises. Participants and coaches are requested to turn off their cellular phones or put them in silent mode. The contestants are not allowed to bring cellular phones and study aids during the contest proper. Contestants should come in their official school uniform.

Contest Guidelines

MECHANICS

3. The student must be currently enrolled either in public or private Secondary/Junior High School, Grades 7 or 8, for SY 2017- 2018. Each district is limited to three entries only, hence, can conduct its own elimination round prior to the division level.
4. The order of speech delivery will be determined through draw lots upon registration. Contestants shall enter the hall one a time, until after one participant shall have finished his/her speech. The contestant will randomly pick a topic that must be addressed in a 3-5 minute speech. Topics will only be given 5 minutes prior to the contestant's turn to deliver his/her speech. Consulting with coaches after having selected a topic is not allowed.
5. There will be colored flags visible to the participant to guide him/her of the time.
Color guide: Green: 3 minutes
Yellow: 4 minutes
Red: 5 minutes

Note: The speaker shall be provided a 30-second extension to wrap things up. Thus, 5 minutes and 30 seconds is the maximum allowed time.

COVERAGE

6. The extemporaneous speech to be delivered, which must be substantially original, should revolve around the theme **"Partnering for Change, Engaging the World"**. Related topics will be based on the following thematic thrusts of ASEAN:
 - a. a people-oriented and people-centered ASEAN
 - b. peace and stability in the region
 - c. maritime security and cooperation
 - d. inclusive, innovation-led growth
 - e. resilient ASEAN
 - f. ASEAN: a model of regionalism, a global player

CRITERIA

7. The contestants will be judged based on the following:
 - content and quality=40%
 - organization and flow of thought=30%
 - voice and delivery (volume, projection, gestures, posture, confidence)=20%
 - grammar=10%

100% TOTAL

8. The one/s in charge will also be awarding certificates to the students with the best speeches on the ASEAN-related theme on the basis of 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners. Certificates will also be distributed to participants, including coaches/teachers who assisted.

WINNERS

9. The decision of the panel of the board of judges will be deemed final. Results will be based on the decision of the board of judges and to be announced during the awarding ceremony.
