**Participation of Baguio City Schools Division to
MILO Little Olympics North and Central Luzon 2017**

1. In support of the celebration of Baguio Day, Hon. Mauricio G. Domogan, City Mayor, approved the inclusion of Milo Little Olympic as one of the sports activities during this event and the DepEd-CAR, Division of Baguio City will participate in the 2017 MILO Little Olympics North and Central Luzon which will be held on September 8-10, 2017 at the different playing venues in the City of Baguio.
2. Participation is open to all public and private elementary and secondary schools.

All coaches and officiating officials (please see list of officiating officials who are recommended to officiate in this 2017 MILO Little Olympics, enclosure number 1 to division memorandum number 244 are required to attend the Opening Ceremony and Solidarity meeting on Friday September 8, 2017 at 8:00AM at the Baguio City Athletic Bowl.
4. The parade is set on September 8, 2017 at 8:00AM at Lake Drive; Program proper is at 9:00AM, Baguio Athletic Bowl. The active participation of officiating officials, coaches and athletes, likewise, the participation and support of Baguio City High School cadets, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Marching Band and Choral; Pines City National High School's Performing Culture and Arts Dance Group are requested. All teachers, non-teaching personnel, administrators, athletes and other participants shall be excused from their classes for this purpose.

5. Participants coming from other divisions/regions will be billeted at the public schools. All school heads of these billeting schools shall have the final meeting on September 6, 2017 at 4:00PM at the Conflate Events Place, 4th Floor, La Azotea Building, Session Road, Baguio City. 6. Two (2) Days service credits/COC's for September 9 and 10, 2017 (Saturday and Sunday) will be granted to teachers, non-teaching personnel and administrators. However, a filled up and duly signed daily time record must be submitted to this Office on or before September 18, 2017 for documentation.
