
In this connection, may we request to kindly help us encourage their Principals and School Head Teacher to participate in this celebration and submit their reports on or before October 6, 2017.

The Girl Scouts of the Philippines will celebrate the Girl Scout Week on September 17-23, 2017 with the theme " **PEACE STARTS WITH ME**". Herewith are following suggested activities that are you can adopt or plan creative and exciting activities relative to the theme of the celebration:

Day 1	September 17	FAMILY DAY Sub-Theme: " Building Respect and Understanding " <u>Suggested Activities:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Have a wellness activity like meditation, yoga, zumba, jogging, biking, etc.Hold a family clinic like family gathering, outdoor activity with other families, etc.Write letters to one another and share stories
Day 2	September 18	GIRL'S DAY Sub-Theme: " Strengthening Ties that Bind Us " <u>Suggested Activities:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Conduct an art therapy like peace collage, painting, photography, etc.Hold sports activities like badminton, volleyball, table tennis, board games, etc.Make a letter of peace or creative cards for your friendsHold a small group study and share stories about peace
Day 3	September 19	COMMUNITY DAY Sub-Theme: " Reaching Out to Others, Specially the Poorest " <u>Suggested Activities:</u> * <ul style="list-style-type: none">Invite a resource speaker on safe and peaceful communitiesOrganize a Community Service Project like Supplementary Feeding, Share-A Meal, KidsFest, etc.
Day 4	September 20	ESCODA DAY Sub-Theme: " Reaching Out to Others, Specially the Poorest " <u>Suggested Activities:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Hold a Josefa Llanes Escoda CeremonyHave an interactive story telling about the life of Josefa Llanes Escoda and GSP historical milestonesHave a short video presentation on the life of our FounderWrite down testimonies from Escoda Memento Fund Beneficiaries/former active girl Scouts in the community on how Girl Scouting has influenced their lives.
Day 5	September 21	ENVIRONMENT DAY Sub-Theme: " A Safe and Peaceful Environment for Humankind " <u>Suggested Activities:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Initiate or join a community project like coastal clean-up, tree planting, beautification of an area, vegetable gardening, etc.Put up environmental booths about the 3Rs, conversation, etc.Conduct a forum about safe and peaceful environmentHold a small group bike ride in a scenic part of the community and immerse yourself in the calm of the environment.
Day 6	September 22	TROOP LEADER'S DAY (TEACHER'S DAY) Sub-Theme: " My Teacher, My hero " <u>Suggested Activities:</u> * <ul style="list-style-type: none">Hold a Recognition Ceremony for your active Troop LeadersMake artistic cards with messages of love or send text messages in appreciation of their hard workCompose an essay, poem or song and give it to your Troop Leader
Day 7	September 23	PARTNERSHIP DAY Sub – Theme: " Creating Peace through Partnerships " <u>Suggested Activities:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Organize an event in partnership with other agencies.Have a booth display of an organization's/agencies mission, vision, product, services, job opening, etc.Invite a resource person who can share something about his/her company.Invite persons from potential partner agencies to witness a Girl Scouting activity.
