


1st Indorsement

2. Interested teams are required to pay a non-refundable entry fee per team, per sports, level. *(Please see below)*



3. Official Registration Form- duly signed by the Principal/School Head, Registrar, Coach, Doctor (with License No.), Athlete and Parents/Guardian with duly attached 1Kg empty foil pack per athlete.

ATHLETES INDIVIDUAL REQUIREMENTS:

4. All schools are required to submit a folder per sport, containing the following:
 - A. Original and photocopy of PSA/NSO per athlete or passport for each student/athlete.
 - B. Form 137 (with or without grades as long as the school year and fresh signature is reflected)
 - C. Four (2) pieces of recent I.D. size (2x2) photo of all participants with the corresponding name tags and team captain/s indicated below each (for Gallery form).
 - D. Elementary students must compete in the elementary division only (7-12 years old) cut off year coverage is born from 2010-2005.
 - E. High School students must compete in the high school division only. The age limit for secondary athlete is 16 years old. The cut-off year is 2001.
 - F. Athletes Gallery Form is DULY SIGNED by the TEAM CAPTAIN, COACH and PRINCIPAL.
 - G. CERTIFICATION from the Principal as the OFFICIAL COACH.
 - H. All competing student athlete must take part in the Opening Ceremonies.
 - I. As an added incentive during the Opening Ceremonies, Plaques of Recognition shall be awarded impromptu to top three (3) schools separately from elementary and high school under the following categories:
 - 1 Biggest Delegation of athletes and supporters who are physically present
 - 2 The School with the Loudest Cheer
 - 3 Best in Parade and Saludo
 - 4 Most Disciplined Delegation
 - 5 Miss MILO Little Olympics
 - 6 Cheer Leading Competition
 - J. Cash Prizes shall be awarded to the Overall top Ten (10) schools for elementary and Top Ten (10) high school.
