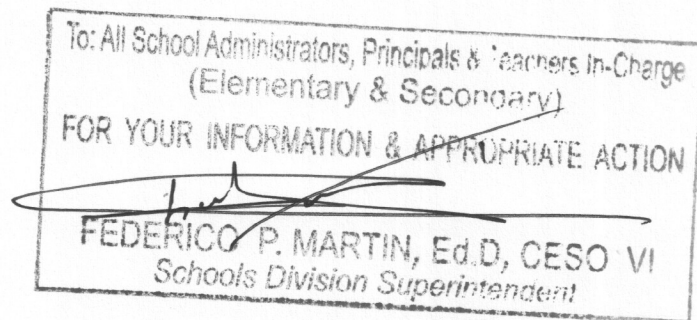

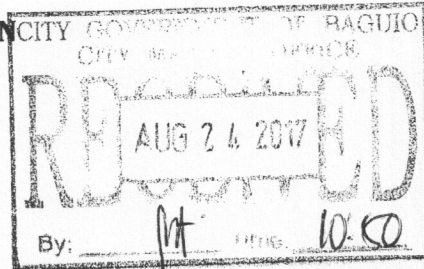

**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

TO : ALL PROVINCIAL GOVERNORS, CITY AND MUNICIPAL MAYORS, ARMM REGIONAL GOVERNOR, AND DILG REGIONAL DIRECTORS

SUBJECT : 2017 NATIONAL TEACHERS' MONTH EVERY SEPTEMBER 5 TO OCTOBER 5 PER PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION NO. 242, S. 2011

The Philippines holds the longest celebration for teachers - **National Teachers' Month** - which is held every *September 5 to October 5* as declared by Presidential Proclamation No. 242 dated August 24, 2011, and the **National Teachers' Day** on the 5th day of October of every year, pursuant to Republic Act No. 10743 (s. 2016). The grand multi-sectoral celebration honors the Filipino teachers and their important role of nurturing minds, and uplifts the noble teaching profession, as well as, inspire the young to consider a career in education.

In this connection, all Provincial Governors, City Mayors and Municipal Mayors are hereby enjoined to come up with support activities in promoting the culture of gratitude to the Filipino teachers, in partnership with the Department of Education, such as, but not limited to the following:

- ✦ organize short yet, meaningful programs honoring the teachers in their respective communities, and invite students to give messages and special presentations,
- ✦ join the nationwide "National Prayer for Teachers" and "Ringling of Bells" which will be done as one nation at exactly 10:05 A.M. on October 5,
- ✦ encourage commercial and retail outlets to offer discounts/freebies or special promos for teachers, or come-up with special "Thank you, Teacher" merchandise during the month,
- ✦ sponsor trainings, seminars and conferences for teachers, as may be hosted by corporate foundations and other organizations,
- ✦ encourage radio and television networks to feature the National Teachers' Month in their shows, where hosts and celebrities greet their teachers, and present special segments honoring teachers, among others.

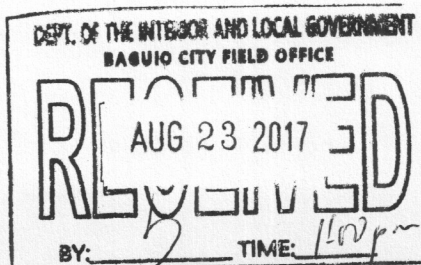

The Philippines holds the longest celebration for teachers — **National Teachers' Month** which is held every September 5 to October 5 as declared by *Presidential Proclamation No. 242* signed in 2011. The grand multi-sectoral celebration honors the Filipino teacher and their important role of nurturing minds. Through NTM, we hope to uplift the noble teaching of profession as well as inspire the young to consider a career in education.

In January 2016, the **Republic Act 10743** or "*An Act Declaring the Fifth Day of October of Every Year as the National Teachers' Day*" was signed into law. The Secretariat has always envisioned a nationwide celebration for teachers much similar to how we celebrate Mothers' Day or Fathers' Day. With RA 10743, we hope that our partners will take an active participation in this milestone day which we will celebrate for the first time on October 5.

The support of the local government units (LGUs) has been an essential element in the success of the celebrations. We have a long tradition of partnership with DILG; every year the Department drafts and releases a Memorandum Circular formally endorsing NTM to all LGUs. the love of learning in us

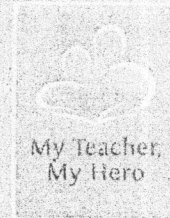
Help them see the potential

new knowledge and experiences

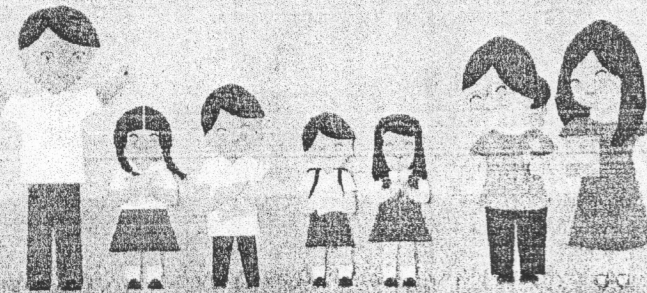
Inspire them to touch the future

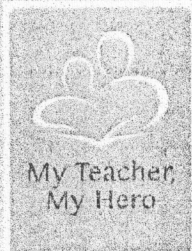
