### **AWARDS MECHANICS AND REQUIREMENTS**

## Most Active Organizations of the Year (open for nomination)

This will be awarded to organizations or formations that showed excellence in forwarding the interests of the Baguio studentry and youth and initiated activities that contributed to the empowerment of the Baguio studentry and youth.

#### Mechanics

The search is open for all youth organizations in schools and local communities in Baguio. This may include school-based political parties, cultural/performing organizations, academic organizations, religious organizations, and other groups whose members are considered youth aged 13-35. The nominated organization shall be required to submit an accomplishment report for the past year.

The organizers will select the three most active and relevant organizations. Each awardee will receive Php 5000 and certificates.

## Aktibong Kabataan of the Year (open for nomination)

This will be awarded to students that showed excellence and leadership in forwarding the interests of the Baguio studentry and youth and helped initiate activities that contributed to the empowerment of the Baguio studentry and youth.

#### Mechanics

The search is open for all youth aged 13-35 in schools and local communities in Baguio. The nominated individual shall be required to submit credentials and an accomplishment report for the past year.

The organizers will select two awardees - a male and a female. Each will receive Php 3000 and certificates.

## Best Youth-led Activities of the Year (open for nomination)

This will be awarded to activities or campaigns launched in the past year initiated by the youth that contributed to the empowerment of the Baguio studentry and youth.

### Mechanics

The search is open for all activities and campaigns launched in the past year initiated by youth organizations in schools and local communities in Baguio. This may include campaigns, forums, publications, cultural activities, etcetera. The activity organizer/s shall be required to submit a report of the nominated activity.

The organizers will select two awardees. Each will receive Php 3000 and certificates.

### **Most Participative Organization or School**

This will be awarded to organizations or institutions that offered the most assistance in the preparation and showed the most active participation in the celebration of the 5<sup>th</sup> Baguio Students Day this September.

### Mechanics

The search is open for all participating youth organizations in schools and local communities in Baguio. This may include school-based political parties, cultural/performing organizations, academic organizations, religious organizations, and other groups whose members are considered youth aged 13-35.

## Criteria

50% attendance, 25% participation, 25% assistance to the preparation

The organizers will select the one most participative organization or school. The organization or school will receive Php 3000 and certificates
