The Seminar-Workshop aims to:

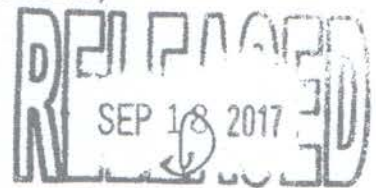
1. enhance the participants' ideas on project management through science investigations;

2. Activities during the NSCM Celebration Seminar/Workshop includes plenary sessions, group dynamics, interactive workshop, round table discussion, poster sessions, practicum, and assessment geared toward the achievement of objectives.
3. The Regional Directors, School Division Superintendents and School Heads are encourage to send their participants to the Seminar/Workshop. The Regional Science Supervisor in charge of the Programs and Projects shall undertake the coordination in the field offices pertinent to their participation in the seminar.
