QUIZ BEE GUIDELINES

1. Each contestant will be provided with slips of paper for the answer to each question. Before the contest proper, the contestant will write the assigned number on each slip.
2. There shall be 20 questions. There are four (4) rounds in each competition namely: Easy, Average, Difficult and Clincher. The Clincher round takes place only if there is a tie. Questions will be read twice by the Quizmaster.
 - a. For the EASY ROUND, ten questions are to be answered mentally. Writing anywhere, neither on paper, the table, etc. is not allowed. After the second (2nd) reading, the Quizmaster shall say "go". Only then will the contestants be allowed to write their answer. Automatically, the fifteen (15) second time - limit will begin with the word "go" by the Quizmaster.
 - b. For the AVERAGE ROUND, five questions are to be answered. After the first (1st) reading, the contestants are allowed to start solving and write their final answer on the slip of paper. Automatically, the thirty (30) second time - limit will begin with the word "go" by the Quizmaster.
 - c. For the DIFFICULT ROUND, five questions are to be answered. The contestants are immediately allowed to solve, and write their answer. A one (1) minute time limit will be given.
 - d. For the CLINCHER ROUND, as many questions as needed are to be answered. The first to get 3 points wins. Questions will be taken from the unread difficult round questions. The contestants are immediately allowed to solve, and write their answer. A one (1) minute time limit will be given.
3. Answers must be given complete with units and to the required accuracy. However if the unit is already given in the way the question is asked, it need not be given in the answer.
4. After the time limit and the buzzer sounds, the contestants must stop writing and raise the slip of paper.
5. The Quizmaster shall read and verify the contestants' answer.
6. Points are assigned for each question answered correctly:
 - . Easy question 2 point
 - . Average question 3 points
 - . Difficult question 5 points
 - . Clincher question 1 points
7. After the fifth (5th) question in the Difficult Round, the total number of points of each contestant is tabulated.

8. The contestant will be ranked according to their total score. The top four will proceed to the Division Level.
9. In case any qualified contestant is unable to compete in the next contest level, the next in rank will take the place of the contestant.
10. The duly registered teacher - coach or contestant are authorized to make a protest.
11. All protest should be referred to the Board of Judges immediately, before the Quizmaster reads the next question.
12. The Board of Judges shall be in complete control of the contest. Their decision shall be final in all questions/ protests.

DAMATH GUIDELINES

1. The first player is determined by table of pairings.
2. Each grade level will have two brackets. No two players of the same school will be in the same bracket.
3. Players will provide their own chips. Measurement of chips will be 3 cm x 3 cm or 3 cm diameter.
4. Players making annoying acts or disturbing sounds such as tapping the table, whistling, etc will be given a maximum of two warnings and will forfeit the game if the player does not heed to the warnings.
5. No coach, spectator, or bystander is allowed within 2 meters of the players while the game is going on.
6. Each player is allotted one minute per move including the recording of the move and the corresponding score in the score sheet.
7. In taking a chip, pass is not allowed. Even if the player has exceeded the one-minute time to move, he/she still needs to make the move. The player will receive a warning and will forfeit the game if the act is done repeatedly.
8. During the last minute of the game, when a player is in the process of taking a chip and the arbiter says "time" then he/she still needs to continue to take the chip. When a player moves a chip that needs to be taken and the arbiter says "time" then the opponent does not need to take the chip because he/she has no more time to take the chip.
9. A player records his/her own move. Only one score sheet is allowed to be accomplished alternately by the two players. When an incorrect entry in the score sheet is observed, a player has to immediately call the attention of the tournament manager. The appropriate corrections should be done by the erring player and will be given a warning.
10. In moving a chip, touch move should strictly be observed unless it is not possible to do so.
11. Defaulting time is five (5) minutes.
12. The game ends if: the 20- minute game period lapsed, the moves are repetitive, a player has no more chips to move, an opponent's chip is cornered, or a player resigns.

13. No complaints will be entertained after the players have signed the score sheets. Only the player and his/her coach can file complaints. The decision of the tournament manager is final and unappealable.

14. The following Tie – breaking rules will be used in case of tie; a. winner over the other, b. SB, c. 10-minute knockout game

Note: Selection of the next venue (2018 District Math Festival) shall be done during the contest day through draw lots.
